Roadways: Highway class pavers and rollers, approved by the City of Burlington shall be used to accomplish the placement and compaction of hot mix asphalt pavement on roadways.

Spreader Specifications

Uniformly heated screed, fully floating, hydraulically operated with gradual vibrating controller and a minimum width of 3m extended to 5m with automatic grade and slope controls. The screed should be capable of producing a desirable, smooth surface and even texture, free of any mat defects such as tearing, shoving, gouging and segregation.

- Hopper capacity: minimum 12 tonne
- Hopper volume: 76 m³
- Track length: 3 m or equivalent with rubber tires
- Operating weight: 16 tonne
- Paving speed: 76 m per minute

Driveways and Multi-Use Pathways:

Spreader Specifications

Uniformly heated screed, fully floating, hydraulically operated with gradual vibrating controller and a minimum width of 2.5m extended to 4m with automatic grade and slope controls. The screed should be capable of producing a desirable, smooth surface and even texture, free of any mat defects such as tearing, shoving, gouging and segregation.

- Hopper capacity: 8 tonne
- Track length: 2 m or equivalent with rubber tires

Uniformly heated screed, fully floating, hydraulically operated with gradual vibrating controller and a minimum width of 2.44m extended to 4.57m with automatic grade and slope controls. The screed should be capable of producing a desirable, smooth surface and even texture, free of any mat defects such as tearing, shoving, gouging and segregation.

Hopper capacity: minimum 6.8 tonne
Track length: 1.96 m or equivalent with rubber tires

The following, issued by the Purchasing Section shall form part of the noted document. The revisions and additions noted herein along with any attachments shall be read in conjunction with all other related documents. This Addendum shall, take precedence over the previously issued documents where differences occur.

1. Please note Specifications 2.4 (page 36) item (3) asks proponents to “Enter unit cost for removal and disposal in Part 1, Section 3, item 2”. The unit cost should be entered in Section 3, items 6.0 to 8.0
2. Specifications 2.4 item 2 requires “Full depth repair areas must be straight saw cut and included in the unit base bid.” The key requirement is the removal of existing material to full depth by Milling or excavation equipment. Please note the city would either accept saw cut straight edge or milling a straight edge.
3. Pricing schedule, section 1, items (3) & (4) for milling and overlay repairs have quantities of 30,000 sq.m. For your information, the average driveway repairs is approximately 100 sq.m to full lane width of roads upwards of 5500 sq.m. On the average, they range from 1500-2000 sq.m size.
4. On page 54 of 64 of the Bid submission form, it asks for Bond or letter of Credit etc. Please note the city has deleted that clause from the tender document. Proponents are only require to submit with their bids a 10% bid bond in the total bid amount.
5. Page 53 of 64 Pricing Schedules, Section 1: Asphalt Repair, proponents are required to transfer only the total extended price to page 48. Please note Section 2: Concrete Repair unit Costs and Section 3: Other Associated Costs are for information only.
