The following list of Acceptable Vendor Supplies is mandatory for our Festivals and Events. Failure to comply may result in the inability to participate as vendors in future events.

Dishware	Fibre based paper or wax paper	<u>Any</u> plastic (Polystyrene, Styrofoam, all compostable or biodegradable plastics)
Serving Buckets, trays, sauce cups or any food packaging	Fibre based paper or wax paper	<u>Any</u> plastic (Polystyrene, Styrofoam, all compostable or biodegradable plastics)
Cutlery/ Stir Sticks	Wood	<u>Any</u> plastic (Polystyrene or compostable plastics)
Hot Drink Cups/ Cold Drink Cups	Paper or wax based cups	<u>Any</u> plastic (Polystyrene, Styrofoam, all compostable or biodegradable plastics)
Food Service Plastic Pails	Clean (i.e. No dough or batter)	Not cleaned out/contaminated
Bulk Condiments	** Bulk Condiment Reusable Dispensers	Any individual plastic or paper serving packets

Compost / Green Cart Program	All food: meats, cheese, milk, butter, dough, batter, fruit, vegetables, coffee grounds  Light paper (paper plates, trays, cups), wet/soiled paper, wax paper, coffee filters, wood cutlery, greasy pizza box)	Bulks or grease  Plastics, metals, glass, cardboard
Blue Box Program	Disposable, rigid, plastic containers and packaging  Single use plastic plates, cups, and coffee cup lids  Plastic food and beverage containers  Plastic bottles  Boxed beverage containers  Glass bottles and jars	Plastic bags, plastic film or Styrofoam  Plastic cutlery



	Aluminum foil, trays, metal food and beverage cans  Newspapers, flyers, fine paper, magazines and books	
Grey Water	Must use bulk grey water container at designated park location	Cannot be left in any container or dumped in any garbage, recycle, or compost barrel
Cardboard	Boxes must be broken down & all plastic and garbage removed.  Boxes that are broken down can be neatly placed next to any blue recycle barrel	Boxes that are not broken down or have any plastic warp, Styrofoam or garbage remaining in them

Vendor Site Policies	Accepted	Not Accepted
Lighting/ Electrical Conservation	Low-wattage/energy-conserving products; compact fluorescent, LED, etc.	Incandescent, halogen
Skids	Cannot be left at site at the end of the Festival – all skids must be taken with you	Any skids left at site
Site Conditions	Clean and tidy at all times  No garbage, recycling and/or corrugate left at site  Wiring, cords and hoses must be clear of any walking traffic  Cable ties off of ground  Site cleared 1 hour after Festival close	Messy and untidy  Garbage, recycling and/or corrugate left at site  Wiring, cords, and hoses deemed a trip hazard  Cable ties left on ground  Site not cleared 1 hour after Festival close
