

**THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BURLINGTON**

**BY-LAW NUMBER 44-2005**

A By-law to amend Group Homes Registration By-law 31-2001.  
File: 501-01-1.48 (CD-123-05)

WHEREAS Section 166 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides for the registration and renewal of group homes,

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BURLINGTON HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. PART 1a of By-law 31-2001 is amended by deleting the existing definition of “Group Home” and replacing it with the following:
  - (a) “Group Home” A single housekeeping unit supervised by staff on a daily basis which provides special care and treatment to persons for physical or mental deficiency, physical handicap or other such cause. A Group Home shall be funded, licensed, approved, or supervised by the Province of Ontario under a general or specific Act, for the accommodation of not less than six and not more than eight residents, exclusive of staff. Where a Group Home is located outside the Urban Improvement Area boundary, the maximum number of residents permitted, exclusive of staff is ten. A Group Home may contain an office provided that the office is used only for the administration of the Group Home in which it is located.
2. This By-law is in full force and effect on the date that Zoning By-law 2020.187 and By-law 45-2005 take effect.
