City of Burlington By-law 55-2024

A by-law to repeal By-law 85-2022, being a by-law to adopt Official Plan Amendment No. 130 to modify the text of the Burlington Official Plan and add a new Table to implement changes that have been made to the *Planning* Act resulting from Bill 109, *More Homes for Everyone Act, 2022.*(L-23-24)

Whereas subsection 21(1) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, as amended, provides that a council of a municipality that is within a planning area may initiate an amendment to any official plan that applies to the municipality, and section 17

Whereas on December 13, 2022, Council of the City of Burlington enacted By-law 85-2022 to adopt Official Plan Amendment No. 130 to modify the text of the Burlington Official Plan and add a new Table to implement changes that have been made to the *Planning* Act resulting from Bill 109, *More Homes for Everyone Act*, 2022; and

Whereas Council of the City of Burlington deems it necessary to repeal By-law 85-2022 in order to withdraw Official Plan Amendment No. 130, as a result of legislative changes introduced by Bill 185, *Cutting Red Tape to Build More Homes Act, 2024*;

Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Burlington hereby enacts as follows:

1. That By-law 85-2022 is hereby repealed:

applies to any such amendment; and

2. That this by-law shall come into full force and take effect of the final day of passing thereof.
