City of Burlington By-law 55-2024

A by-law to repeal By-law 85-2022, being a by-law to adopt Official Plan Amendment No. 130 to modify the text of the Burlington Official Plan and add a new Table to implement changes that have been made to the *Planning Act* resulting from Bill 109, *More Homes for Everyone Act, 2022*.
(L-23-24)

Whereas subsection 21(1) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, as amended, provides that a council of a municipality that is within a planning area may initiate an amendment to any official plan that applies to the municipality, and section 17 applies to any such amendment; and

Whereas on December 13, 2022, Council of the City of Burlington enacted By-law 85-2022 to adopt Official Plan Amendment No. 130 to modify the text of the Burlington Official Plan and add a new Table to implement changes that have been made to the *Planning Act* resulting from Bill 109, *More Homes for Everyone Act, 2022*; and

Whereas Council of the City of Burlington deems it necessary to repeal By-law 85-2022 in order to withdraw Official Plan Amendment No. 130, as a result of legislative changes introduced by Bill 185, *Cutting Red Tape to Build More Homes Act, 2024*;

Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Burlington hereby enacts as follows:

1. That By-law 85-2022 is hereby repealed;
2. That this by-law shall come into full force and take effect of the final day of passing thereof.
