Independent Auditor's Report

Qualified Opinion

We have audited the accompanying Financial Statement – Auditor's Report Form 4 (the "Financial Statements") of Marianne Meed Ward (the "Candidate"), which comprise the statement of campaign income and expenses, calculation of surplus or deficit and all related schedules for the period May 1, 2018 to December 31, 2018. The Financial Statements have been prepared by the Candidate in accordance with Section 88.25 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 (the "Act").

In our opinion, except for the possible effects of the matters described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph, these Financial Statements present fairly, in all material respects, the campaign income, expenses and deficit for the period May 1, 2018 to December 31, 2018 in accordance with the Act.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the nature of the types of transactions inherent in an election campaign, the completeness of campaign income and expenses is not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, our verification of campaign income and expenses was limited to the amounts recorded in the accounting records of the Candidate and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to the statement of campaign income and expenses, calculation of deficit and all related schedules for the period May 1, 2018 to December 31, 2018.

Emphasis of Matter - Basis of Accounting and Restriction on Use and Distribution

The Financial Statements are prepared in accordance with a special purpose framework as prescribed by the Act, and have been prepared to assist the Candidate to meet the requirements of the Act. As a result, the Financial Statements may not be suitable for another purpose. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter. Our Report is intended solely for the use of the Candidate and the City of Burlington and should not be distributed to parties other than the Candidate and the City of Burlington.

Responsibilities of the Candidate and Those Charged with Governance for the Financial Statements

The Candidate is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these Financial Statements in accordance with the Act and for such internal controls as the Candidate determines is necessary to enable the preparation of Financial Statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility for the Audit of the Financial Statements

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the Financial Statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these Financial Statements.

As part of an audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit.
