Appleby Creek Erosion Control Project Lakeshore Road to Lake Ontario Notice of Public Information Centre

BACKGROUND

Erosion Control Environmental Assessment (EA) Study completed in 2020 identified channel erosion and slope destabilization within the Appleby Creek corridor from South Service Road to Lake Ontario. The EA recommended the implementation of erosion mitigation strategies to be implemented in multiple phases.

In the first phase, the City of Burlington will be undertaking Appleby Creek restoration works from upstream of Lakeshore Road to Lake Ontario for approximately 210m as shown in the figure. The restoration works will include bank protection, minor channel realignment, profile corrections for fish habitat improvements and provide protection to the Lakeshore Road bridge area.

PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT

As public engagement is an important part of the city projects, the City will be holding the Public Open House where the final design and implementation (construction) timing will be discussed. Public input and comments are welcomed and will be considered in the completion of the project.

Online Public Information Centre

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, an Online Public Information Centre (PIC) will be hosted where the residents will have an opportunity to share input, concerns, and comments regarding the construction of the project.
