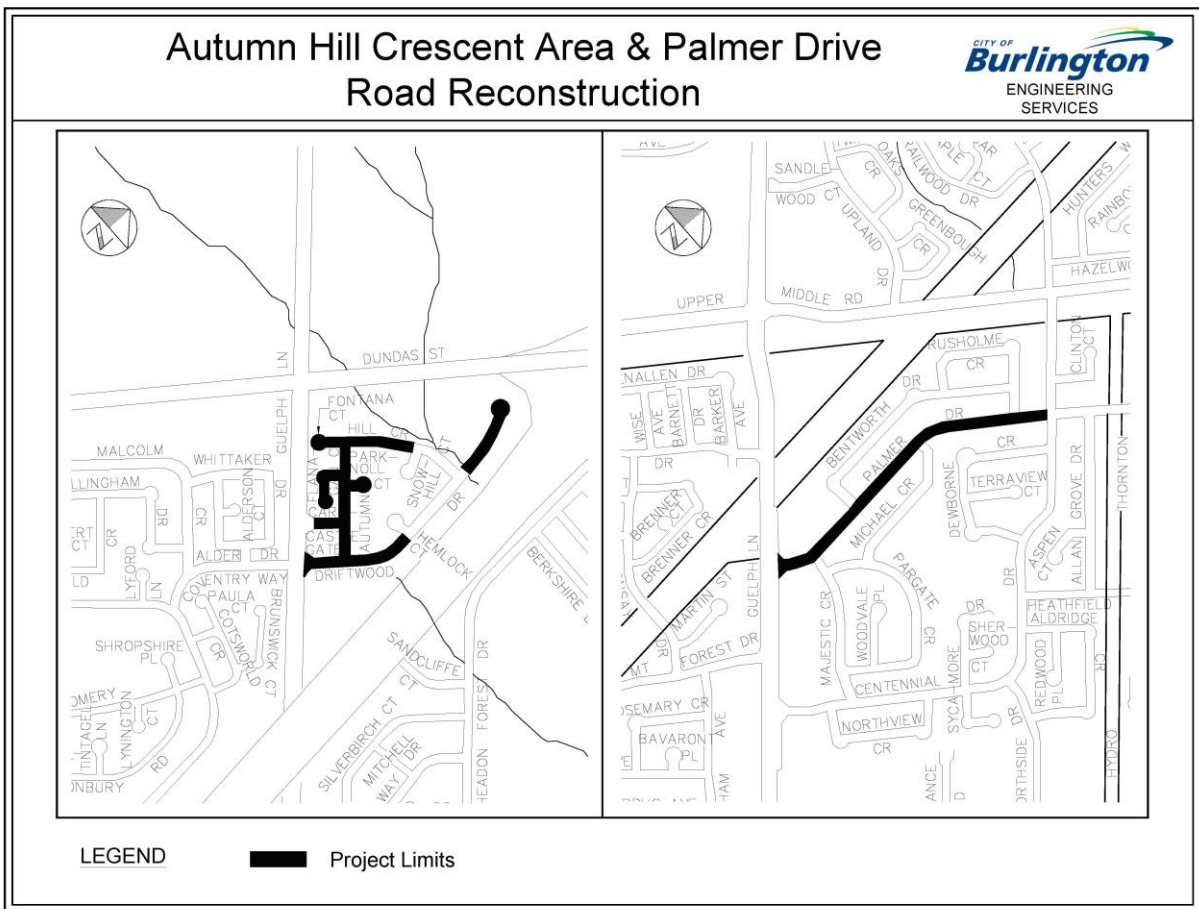




# There are changes happening in your community

**Project Schedule**

The project has experienced notable delays in the completion of third-party locates, and industry-wide concrete shortages. These and other factors outside of our Contractor’s control, like an increase in concrete sidewalk works, storm sewer replacement, and watermain works, has required the project completion date to be extended into Spring 2023.

Street lighting and underground watermain and storm works will be complete on all streets in 2022. Concrete, asphalt, and boulevard restoration works are scheduled to be completed on Palmer Dr. in November 2022.



# There are changes happening in your community

Autumn Hill Cres. and Driftwood Dr. will have all curb replaced and the roadway paved to base asphalt in 2022. Every effort will be made to complete all sidewalk and driveway restoration on these streets, but will be completed in sections as time and weather permits in 2022, with any remaining concrete works, final adjustments, and top asphalt being completed in April/May 2023. Any driveways not able to be paved with permanent asphalt this year will have temporary asphalt placed for the winter.

The remaining curb and asphalt works on Carncastle Gate, Flanagan Ct., Fontana Ct., Driftwood cul-de-sac, and Park Knoll Ct. will be completed in April/May 2023.

## **Leaf Collection Cancellation**

The City is unable to complete curbside leaf collection within the project limits due to newly placed material in the boulevards and access interruptions due to the ongoing construction. Leaf pick-up will not take place on Palmer Dr. from Guelph Line to Centennial Dr., Autumn Hill Cr., and Driftwood Dr. from Guelph Line to Hemlock Ct. this Fall 2022. Residents are asked to bag the leaves and place them at the roadside for Halton Region Yard Waste pick-up. contradiction to the below by-law, register your vehicle for the On-Street Parking Exemption Program at:

The parking exemption allows a vehicle to park on the street beyond the 5-hour limit or overnight between 1 a.m. to 6 a.m., up to 15 days per calendar year, per license plate.

The only two parking offences waived AFTER a vehicle is registered for a parking exemption are:

1. park exceeding 5-hour limit
2. park between 1 a.m. to 6 a.m.

All other parking offences apply as they are not part of the parking exemption program.
