## Grindstone Creek Erosion Control Project Waterdown Road to Hidden Valley Park Notice of Public Information Centre

### BACKGROUND

Erosion Control Environmental Assessment (EA) Study completed in 2020 identified significant erosion concerns as requiring rehabilitation for the Grindstone Creek, between Waterdown Road and Hidden Valley Park. The EA recommended the implementation of erosion mitigation strategies to be implemented.

The City of Burlington will be undertaking Grindstone Creek restoration works from downstream of CN Rail to downstream of Howard Road culvert for approximately 130m as shown in the figure. The restoration works will include bank protection using vegetated buttress and the construction of scour pool downstream of the Howard Road culvert.

### PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT

As public engagement is an important part of the city projects, the City will be holding the Public Open House where the final design and implementation (construction) timing will be discussed. Public input and comments are welcomed and will be considered in the completion of the project.

### Online Public Information Centre

Online Public Information Centre (PIC) will be hosted where the residents will have an opportunity to share input, concerns, and comments regarding the construction of the project.
