New Street Bridge Replacement at Tuck Creek

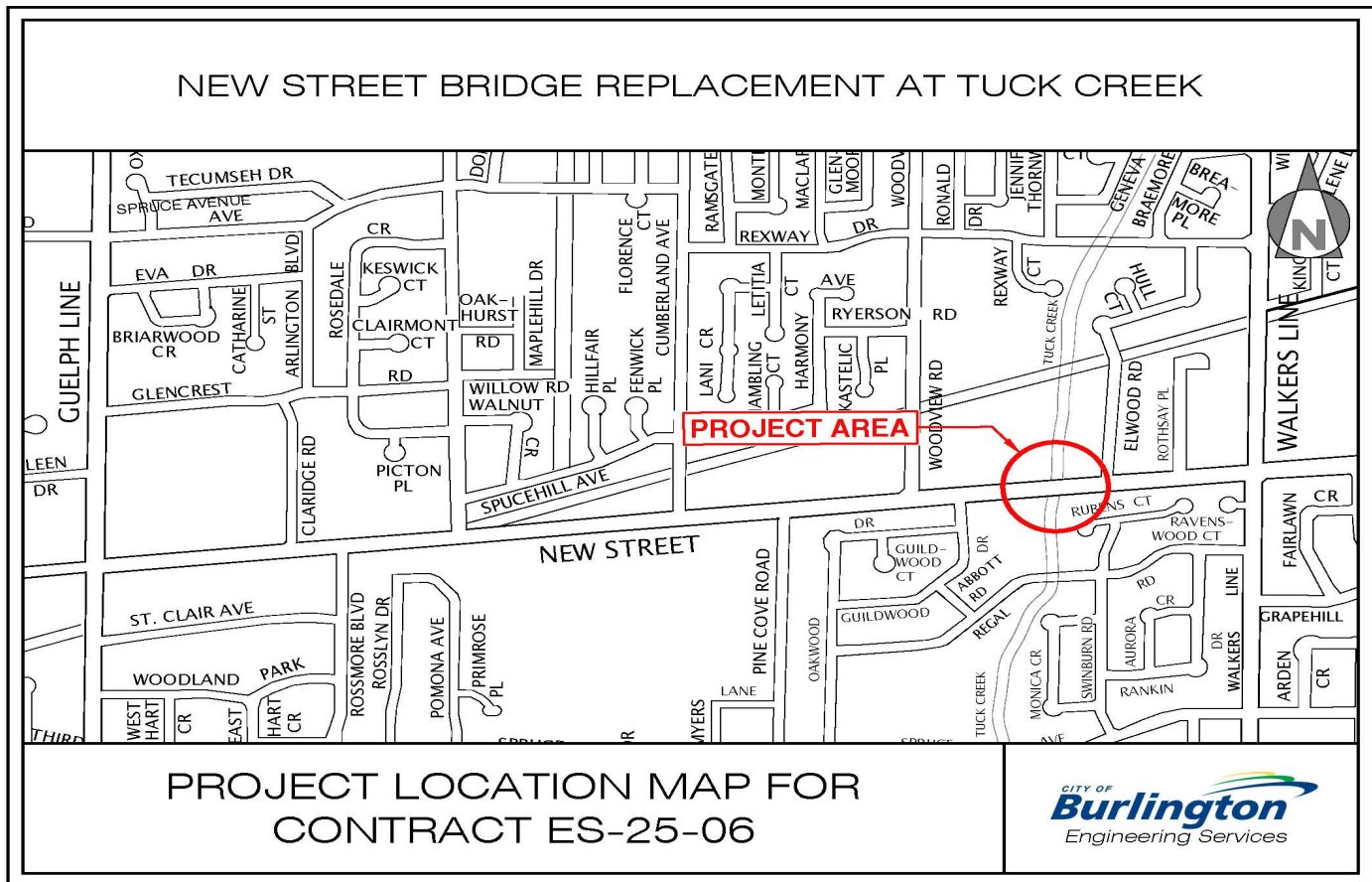
Project Update – July 2025

The City of Burlington will be continuing improvements on New Street at Tuck Creek. This will include the replacement of the New Street Bridge at Tuck Creek, road resurfacing, and storm water culvert replacement.

The New Street bridge will be continue construction mid-July.

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Project Scope and Schedule

Construction activity will commence the June 2025, and proceed as detailed below. Please note that this construction schedule is tentative and subject to change.

Location	Scope	Schedule
New Street Bridge at Tuck Creek	• Replacement of the bridge structure • Storm water management improvements • Road resurfacing	June 2025 – November 2026 Note: During bridge construction, traffic will be staged allow the work to occur while maintaining vehicle flow in both directions. Lane reductions are anticipated on New Street within the project area. A single lane in each direction will be maintained for vehicle travel.

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Utilities

Disruption to your home internet or telephone service may occur. This is a concern for those working and schooling from home, the City has flagged this concern with utility companies. Our goal is to have internet disconnections repaired by the provider within 24 hours. The Contractor will typically contact the utility company, however, if you lose service, please inform your utility provider and the City of the interruption.

Vibration

You may experience some minor vibration from construction equipment. As a precaution, we recommend that you remove or secure objects on shelves and walls.

Tree Removals

Tree protection barriers will be erected around all trees within the right-of-way. Some trees will require removal or pruning.

Road Closures/Lane Restrictions

Lane restrictions will be in place during construction, traffic in the surrounding area will be impacted.
