

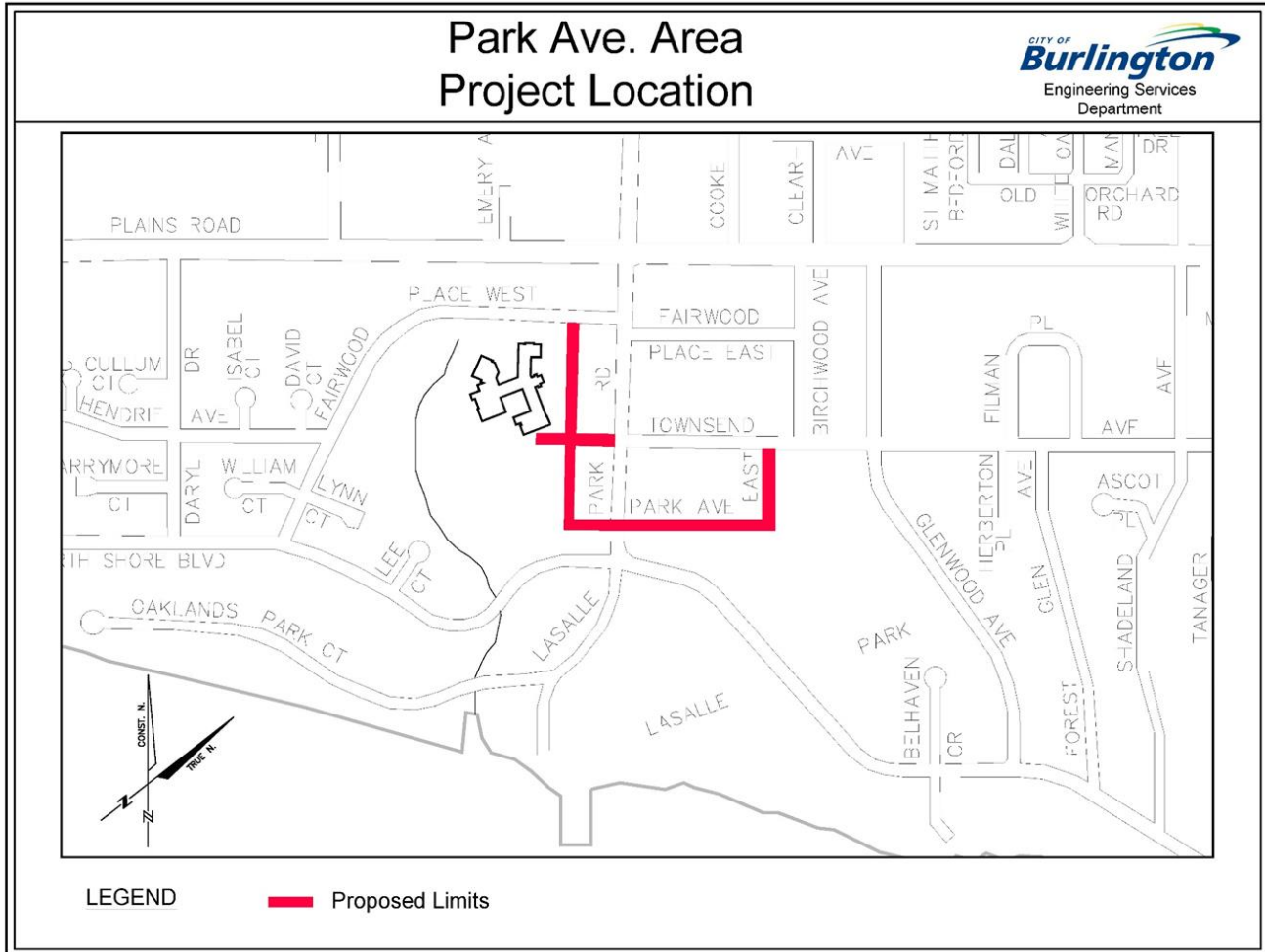

All Streets (including LaSalle Park Drive)	Street lighting upgrades	Spring/Summer 2026

A Project Update, with updated scheduling, will be provided to residents in Spring 2026.

Leaf Collection - November 24th – 28th

Due to the ongoing construction, the City is unable to complete regular loose-leaf collection on all streets within the project limits. As a part of this project, the loose-leaf collection will be completed by the Contractor from November 24th – 28th, 2025. Any efforts made by residents to bag leaves and place at the curbside is appreciated.

Residents are asked to bag or accumulate leaves and keep them at the roadside for pick-up.

Winter Construction Shutdown and Maintenance

Active construction will pause during the winter months. The construction shutdown will take place from January to March 2026, weather dependant. The City will be completing all road maintenance during this time.

Once construction concludes for the season, the City will be completing all winter road maintenance throughout the project limits.

Trees

There will be boulevard trees removed due to conflict with the construction of the proposed curb and sidewalks on Park Ave. E in 2025 as viewable on PIC package on the project website. Potential removals due conflict with the replacement water and wastewater mains and services/laterals remain and will be reviewed on an individual basis.

Canada Post

Canada Post is coordinating the installation of temporary mailboxes of Fairwood PI. Additional information will be provided by Canada Post.
