Further to the Project Update issued in March 2026, you are receiving this notice because night work is planned adjacent to your property. This night work is required to facilitate the installation of a watermain valve chamber in the Brant Street and Prospect Street Intersection, reducing the impacts on local businesses and minimizing disruption to traffic flow within the area.

Please be advised that nightwork is scheduled to occur from 7:00 pm to 7:00 am, starting on (Sunday night) May 31, 2026 through Thursday June 4, 2026 in the vicinity of Prospect Street and Brant Street. We will make every effort to complete the construction work as quickly as possible to minimize the impact of this work.

Below is a list of activities you may notice:

- Excavators will be in use.
- Temporary restoration of the excavated area including backfilling and compaction
- Lighting – task lights will be used with all lights positioned to shine internally on the site.
