



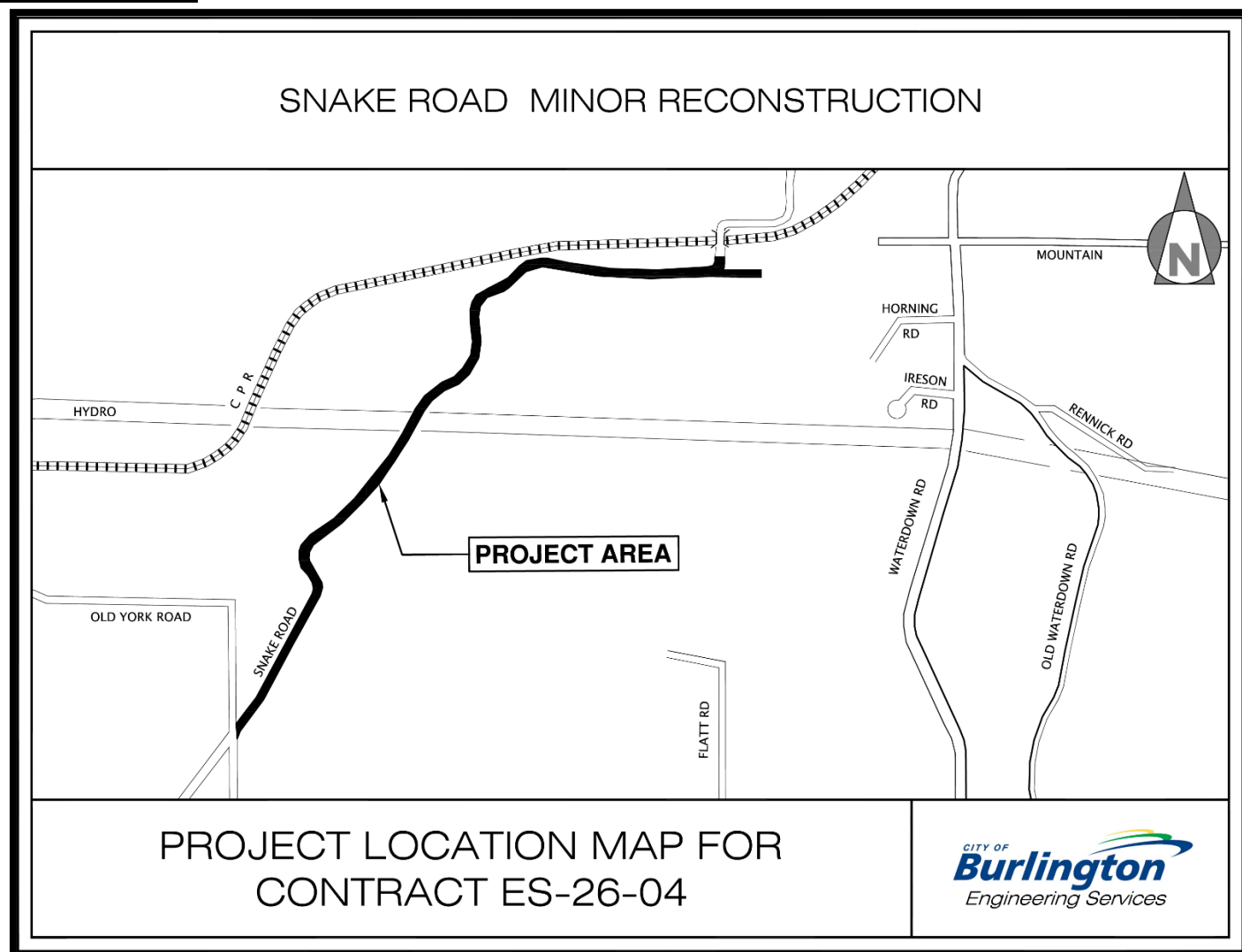
Snake Road Minor Reconstruction Project Update – July 2026

Rankin Construction has been awarded the Snake Road Minor Reconstruction Contract that will be starting at the end of July. This work is to replace roadway surfaces and localized storm culverts in poor condition. This work will involve the removal and replacement of the asphalt surface. Also included will be isolated curb repairs/replacement where required.

Every effort will be made to keep disruptions to a minimum. Construction signs will be posted, and the work site will be secured. For your safety, please use caution and obey all signs.

Utilities

Utilities such as Union Gas, Hydro and Bell Canada have already started to locate their existing infrastructure to prepare for this construction. ***Please do not remove these marker stakes or paint markings. Staff will return to remove them once the project is complete.***

Access to Your Home

Please note that during normal construction hours (Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.) vehicle access to and from your properties may at times be difficult, additionally, driveways will be temporarily closed when work is being carried out in the immediate area. Either the inspector or the contractor will notify you of access interruptions before the closure.

Your Front Lawn and Driveway

As part of this project, the curb may be replaced. Minor regrading of your boulevard lawn near the road will be required. Any damage to your lawn, walkways, and driveways will be restored. For information regarding driveway credits, please visit the project website.

Road Closures/Lane Restrictions

Lane restrictions will be in place during construction. You will still have access to your home. Additional information will be provided during construction.

Garbage Pick up

Please continue to put your garbage and recycling out on the usual day. It is the contractor's responsibility to move your garbage and recycling to a location that can be accessed by the garbage truck and return your garbage/recycling containers. To help the contractor, we ask that you mark your house number on your garbage cans and recycle bins.

Lawn Irrigation System

If you have a lawn irrigation system where curb are to be replaced. We request that you flag all irrigation heads, so they are not damaged. The City is not responsible for damaged heads within the road allowance. This does not have to be done until work in your area is scheduled.

Vibration

At times, you may experience some minor vibration from construction equipment. We recommend that you remove small, light objects from shelving around the house.

Trees

Tree protection barriers will be erected around all trees in the right-of-way, within the construction limits, with an opening to allow homeowner access to maintain the area within.

There will be a number of boulevard trees removed due to conflict with the construction, and it has been determined that these removals are unavoidable. Homeowners adjacent to these removals will each be informed prior to removal. The specific trees that require removal can be viewed on the project drawings on the project website.

If additional trees require removal due to unforeseen impact or conflict, homeowners will be informed.
