# **Land Acknowledgement**

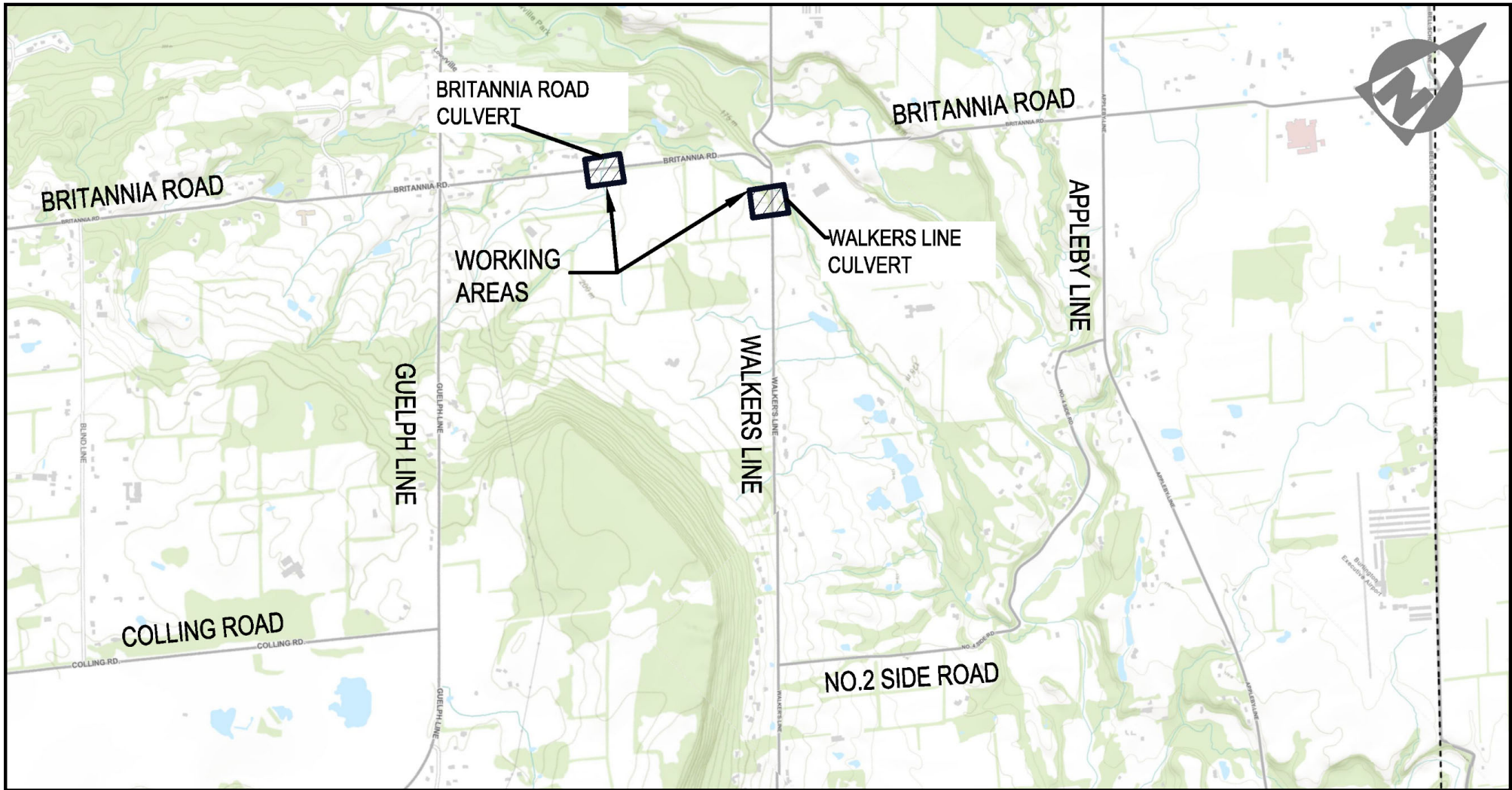
Burlington as we know it today is rich in history and modern traditions of many First Nations and the Métis.

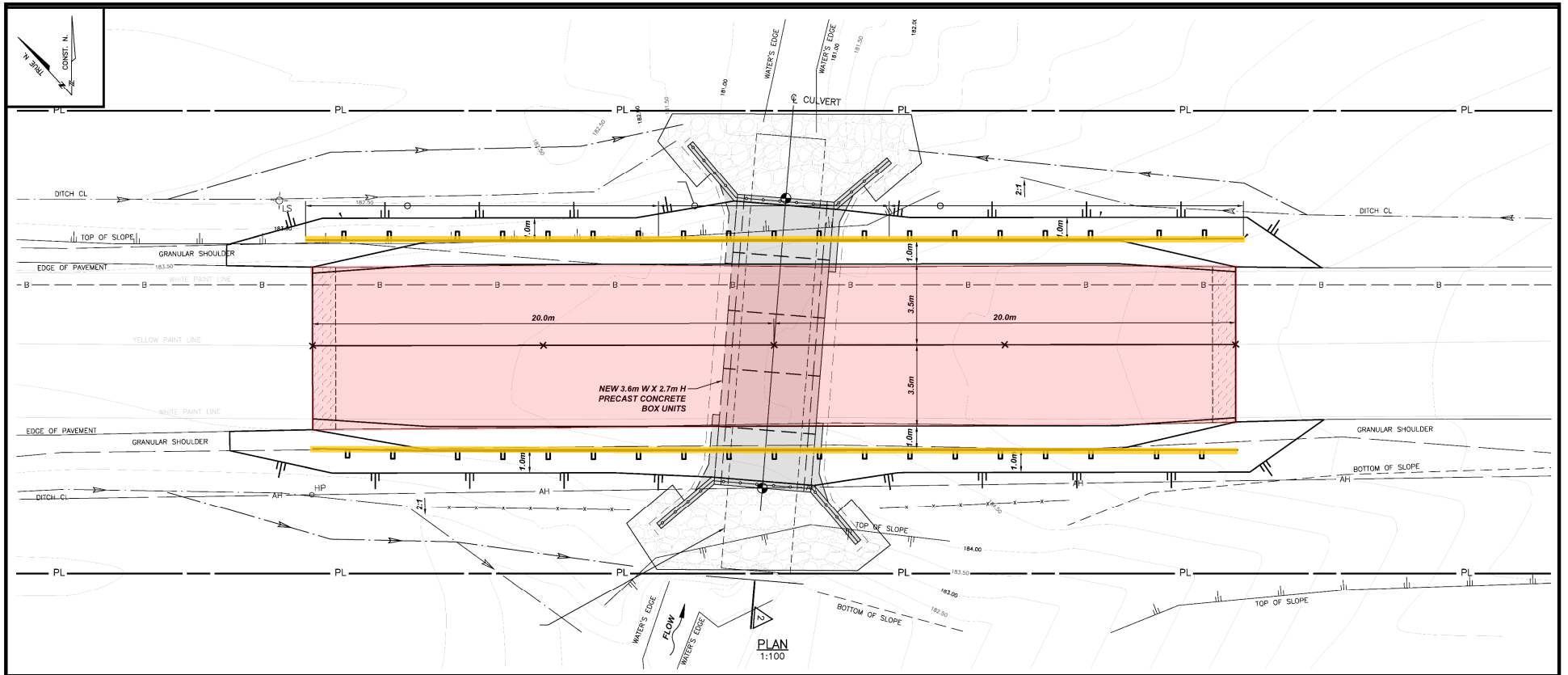

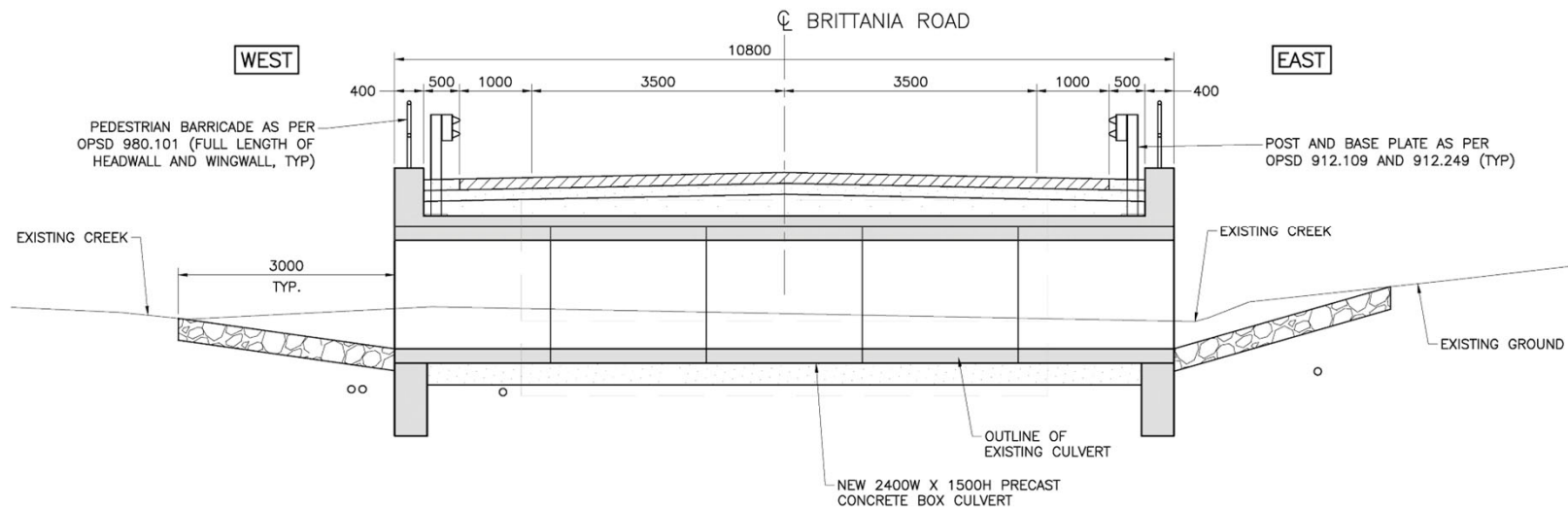

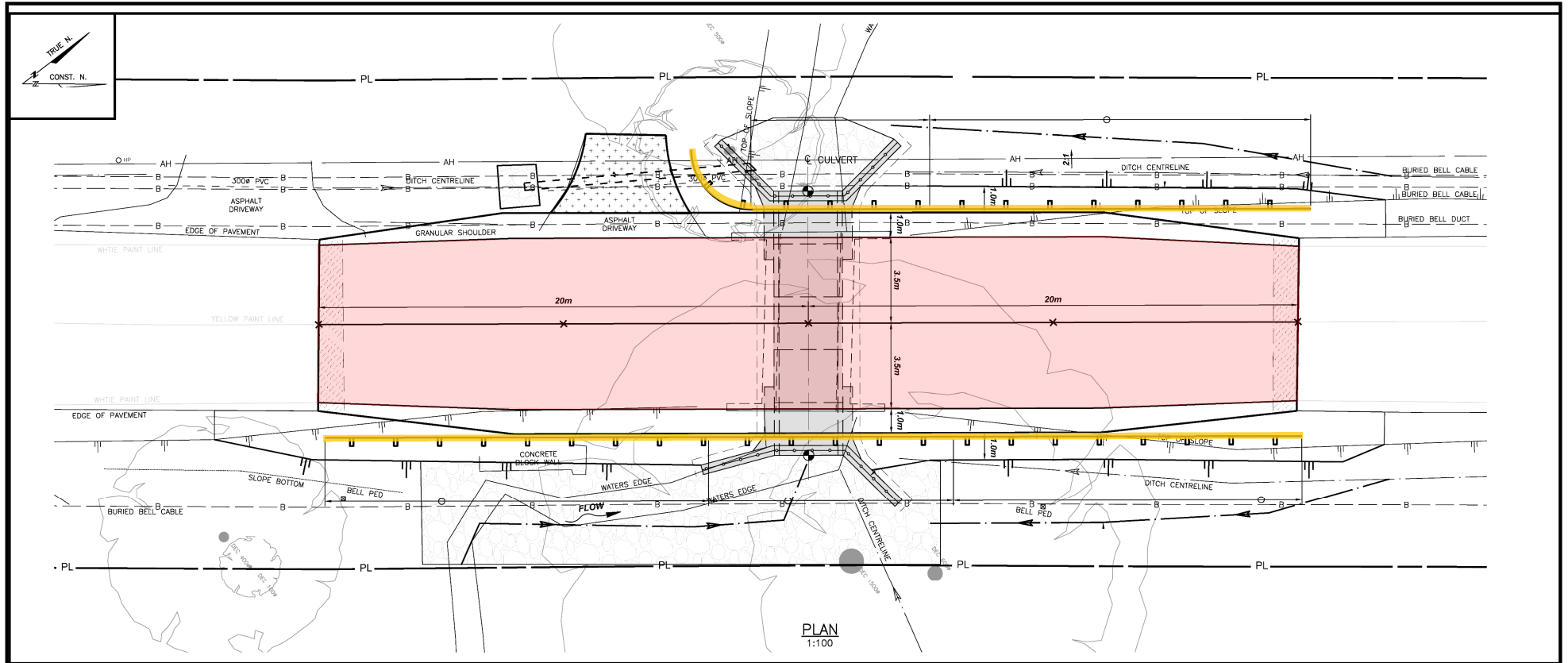

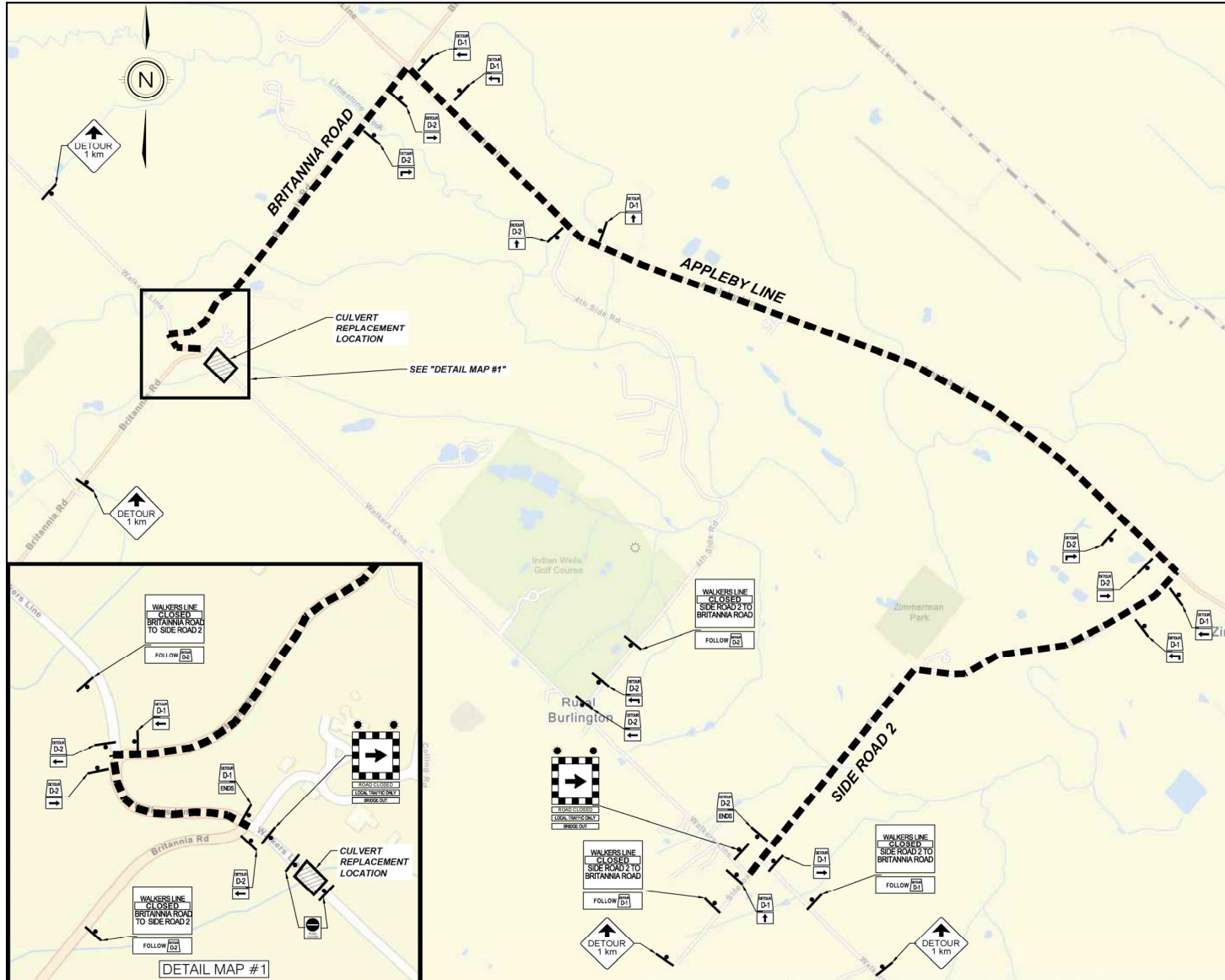

# Detour Route – Walkers Line Culvert (2025)



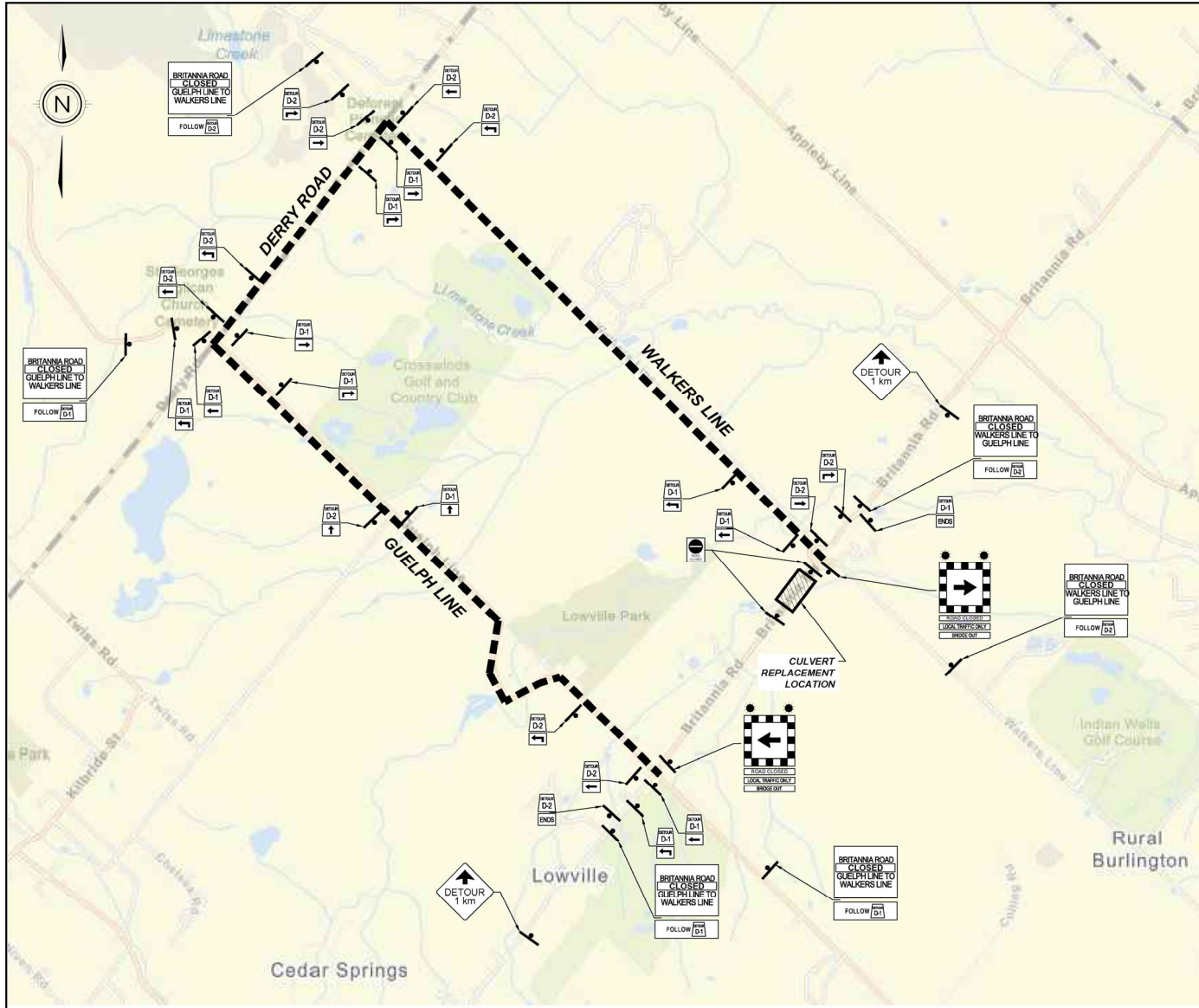

# Additional Information

## Trees

Tree protection barriers will be erected around all trees in the right-of-way, within the construction limits, with an opening to allow property owners access to maintain the area within.

If additional trees require removal due to unforeseen impact or conflict, property owners will be informed.

## Road Closures and Access

Lane closures and localized road closures will be necessary to complete the proposed works. Vehicle traffic will be able to detour around the construction area using the signed detour routes.

Local Access to driveways will be maintained at all times during the project work.

## Garbage Pick-up

Please continue to put your garbage and recycling out on the usual day. To help the contractor return your bins to you when they need to be relocated for pick-up, we ask that you write your house number on your garbage cans, recycling bins, and green carts.

## Noise

Construction noise levels will be enforced as per local By-Law

## Detour Signage

Advanced detour signage will be installed ahead of construction to provide information regarding the upcoming detour routing and timing of any scheduled road closures.
