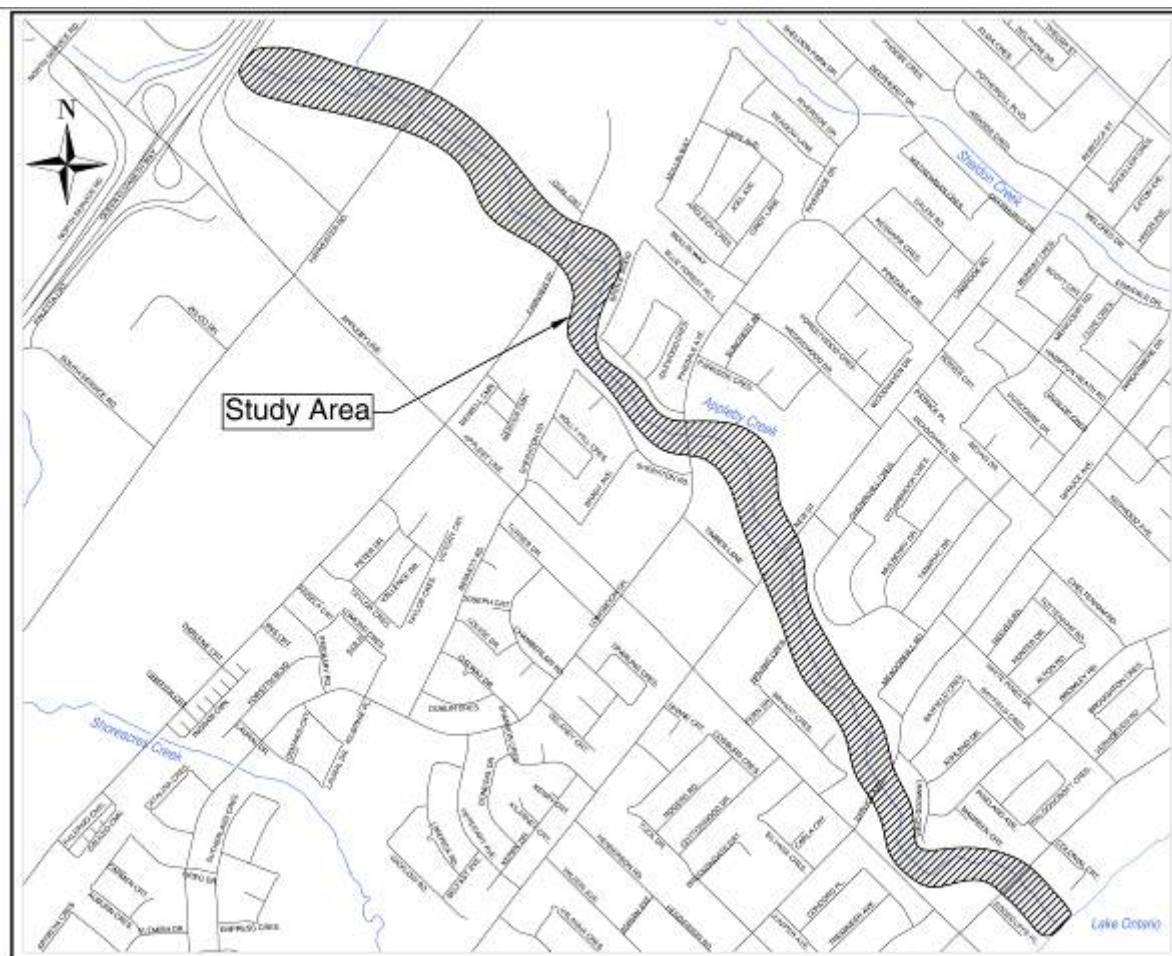
Appleby Creek Erosion Control
Class Environmental Assessment

The Study

The City of Burlington is studying the risk of erosion related to Appleby Creek from Lakeshore Road to the Queen Elizabeth Way Highway. The objective of the study is to provide recommendations to reduce erosion and protect the natural heritage in the area.

Alternative erosion mitigation strategies will be investigated, which will include channel restoration and stabilization of Appleby Creek. Opportunities for natural channel design and native restoration practices will be looked at.

The Process

The Appleby Creek Erosion Control Municipal Class Environmental Assessment is subject to the requirements of the *Ontario Environmental Assessment Act* as a project that will follow the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Schedule B process. Once the existing conditions and problems are identified, solutions will be evaluated and shared with the public and agencies for comment.

Public Interaction

The City will give residents the chance to learn more about the project and comment at a Public Information Centre, which will be advertised in The Burlington Post.
