## Appleby Creek Erosion Control Class Environmental Assessment South Service Road to Lake Ontario

### Notice of Public Information Centre

#### The Study

The City of Burlington is studying the risk of erosion related to Appleby Creek from South Service Road to Lake Ontario. The objective of the study is to give recommendations to reduce erosion and protect the natural heritage in the area.

Other strategies to reduce erosion will be investigated, which will include channel restoration and stabilization of Appleby Creek. Opportunities for natural channel design and native restoration practices will be looked at.

#### The Process

The Appleby Creek Erosion Control Municipal Class Environmental Assessment is subject to the requirements of the *Ontario Environmental Assessment Act* as a project that will follow the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Schedule B process. As a requirement of the process, when the existing conditions and problems are identified, solutions are evaluated and shared with the public and agencies for comments.

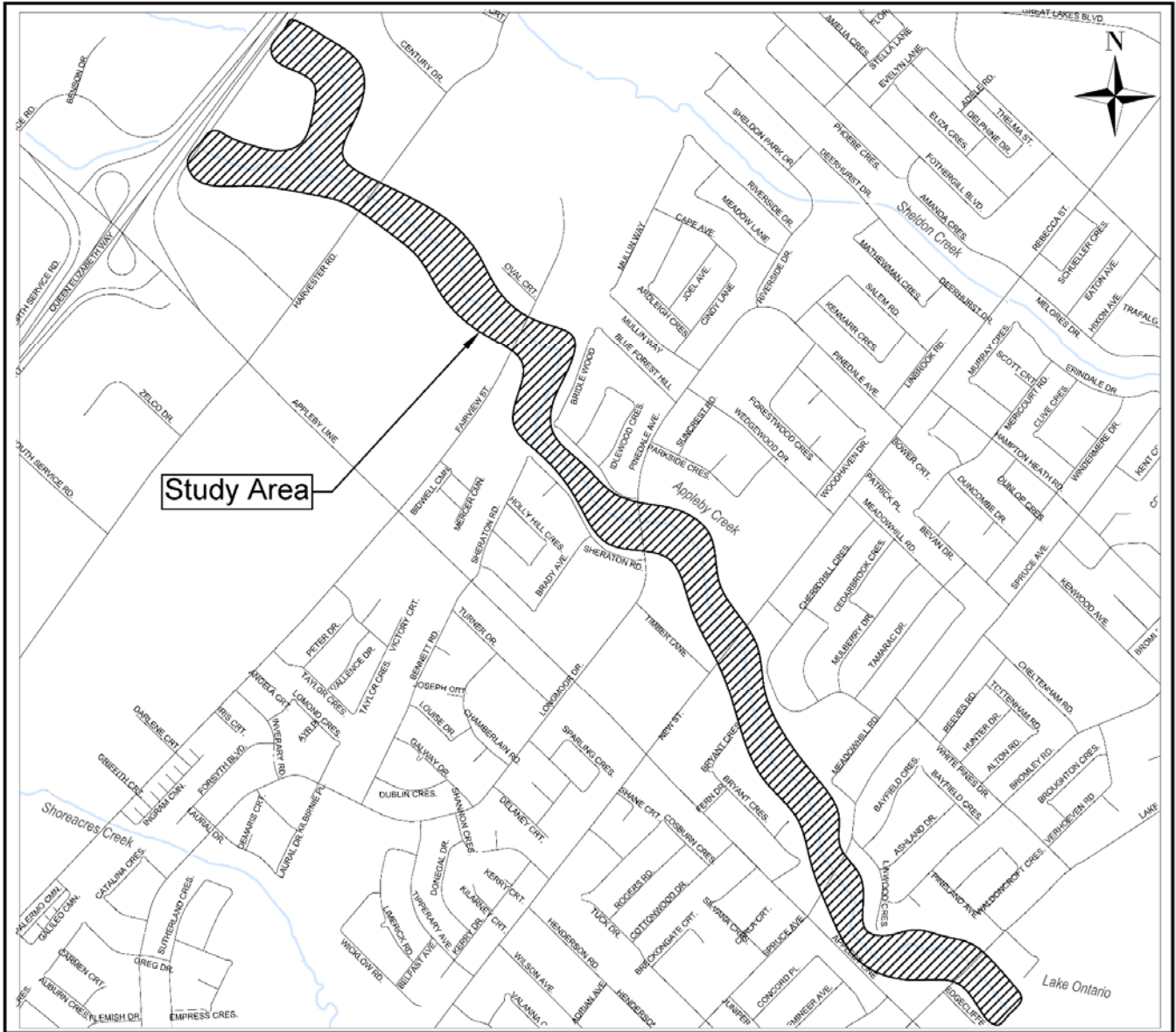
