## NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION

### Roseland Creek Culvert Upgrades at New Street and Lakeshore Road Class Environmental Assessment

The City of Burlington has completed the Roseland Creek culvert upgrades at New Street and Lakeshore Road Environmental Assessment Study.

**The purpose of the study** was to determine the best solution to reduce flooding in the Roseland Creek watershed from Glencrest Road to Lake Ontario, and focused on buildings near the New Street Culvert and Lakeshore Road Culvert to reduce the number of buildings within the floodplain.

The study area is shown in this map:



The recommended solution is to:

- replace the Lakeshore Road bridge with a wider bridge
- restore the creek in the area to improve water flow during high rains to reduce flooding and overflow
- keep the existing bridge at New Street, and when it needs to be replaced, use a larger culvert or bridge at that time.

The study has been conducted in accordance with the Schedule B process as outlined in the Municipal Engineers Association's Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (October 2000, as amended in 2007 and 2011). The city has prepared a Project File Report (PFR) to document solutions and the initial design of the solution.

If concerns with the project cannot be resolved in discussion with city staff, a person or party may request the Minister of the Environment and Climate Change to issue an order for the project to comply with Part II of the *Environmental Assessment Act* (referred to as a Part II Order), which addresses individual environmental assessments.

Requests must be received by the Minister at the address below within 30 calendar days of this Notice, with a copy sent to Arif Shahzad, City of Burlington. If there are no requests received by this date, the city may proceed with design and construction of the project as per the Project File Report.
