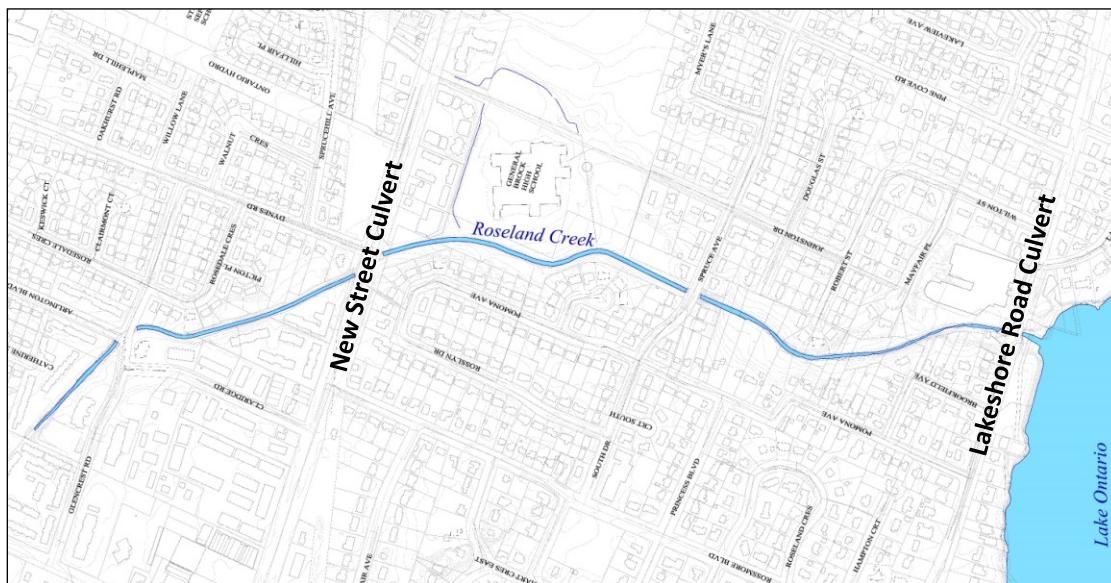


# MUNICIPAL CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE

## ROSELAND CREEK CULVERT UPGRADES (At New Street and Lakeshore Road)

### Project Background

The City of Burlington is studying the problem of flooding risks associated with Roseland Creek culverts at New Street and Lakeshore Road. Options include replacement of the culverts along with adjustments of the Roseland Creek channel.



### The Study Process

The Roseland Creek Culvert Upgrades at New Street and Lakeshore Road study will follow the Schedule B process in accordance with the "Municipal Class Environmental Assessment" document (Municipal Engineers Association, October 2000, as amended in 2007, 2011 and 2015), under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act. The process includes public and review agency consultation, an evaluation of alternatives, an assessment of potential environmental impacts of the proposed improvements and identification of reasonable measures to reduce any negative impacts.
