Tuck Creek Erosion Control Class Environmental Assessment

Harvester Road to Hydro Right of Way, Palmer Drive to CN Rail & Dundas Street to Headon Road

The Study

The City of Burlington has retained Aquafor Beech Limited to undertake a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) to study erosion related risks to three segments of Tuck Creek: i) from Dundas Street to Headon Road, ii) Palmer Drive to the CN Rail, and iii) Harvester Road to the Hydro Right of Way. The study areas are illustrated on the following page.

The objective of the study is to address creek erosion, protect infrastructure and private properties, and enhance the natural heritage of the Tuck Creek corridor. Alternative strategies will be investigated, including restoration and stabilization of Tuck Creek using natural and engineered approaches.

The Process

The Tuck Creek Erosion Control Municipal Class Environmental Assessment will be conducted as a Schedule B Project in accordance with the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment which is an approved process under the *Ontario Environmental Assessment Act*. The Class EA process includes public and review agency consultation, an evaluation of alternatives, an assessment of potential environmental effects of the proposed improvements, and identification of reasonable measures to mitigate any potential adverse impacts.

Online Public Information Centre

Due to the ongoing Public Health Emergency related to COVID-19, an Online Public Information Centre (PIC) will be available to the public to provide input on the Tuck Creek Erosion Control EA.
