

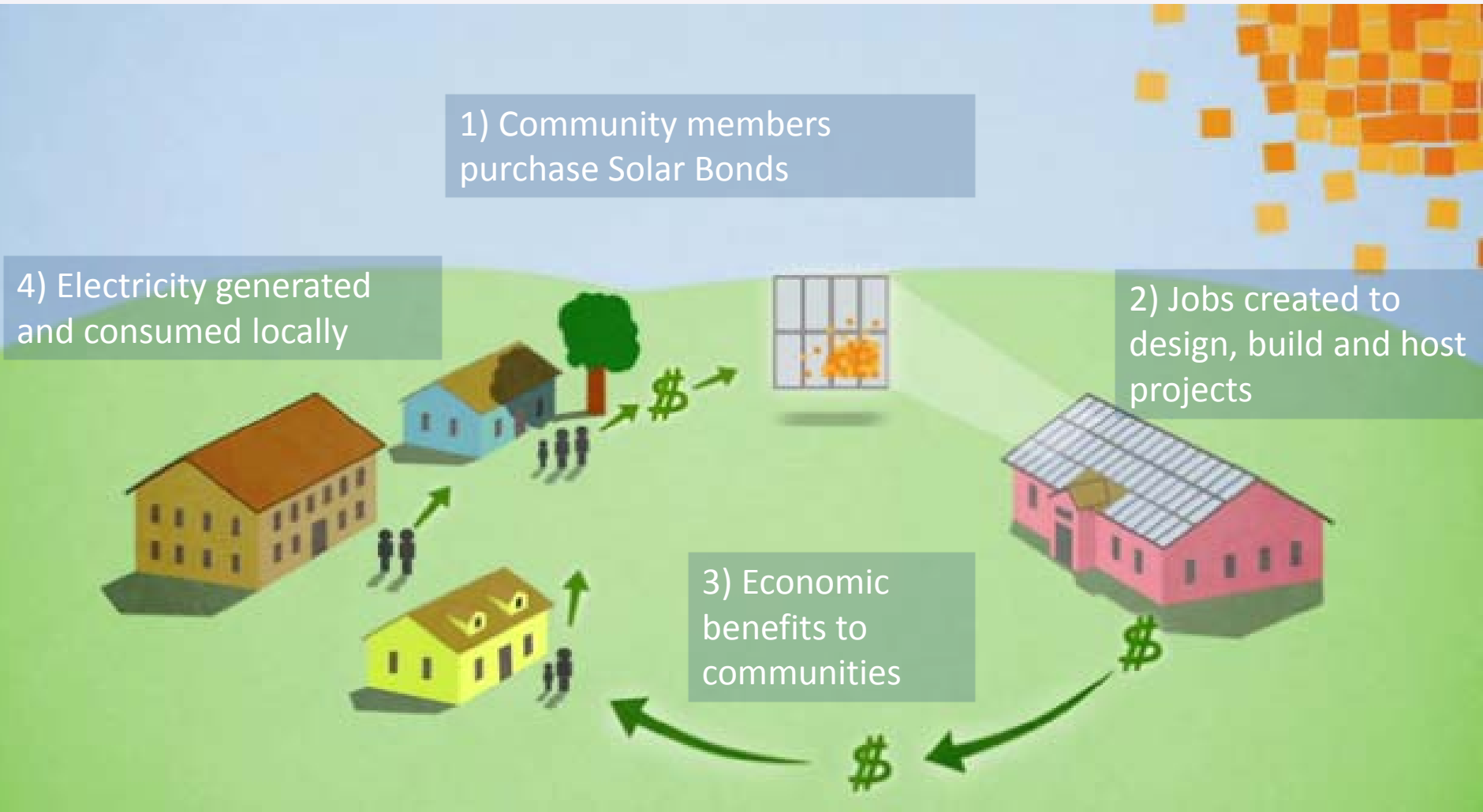


Who We Are

- Canada's largest renewable energy co-operative
 - Not for profit, member based
 - Enabled by Ontario's Green Energy Act
- By mid-2017, 47 solar projects totaling 13 MW and \$55 million in assets
 - More than \$26 million in Solar Bonds sold and \$2.4 million in interest returned to investors
- Mission: To grow solar electricity generation in Ontario by engaging citizens in projects that offer tangible financial, social and environmental returns

your roof to invest in solar!

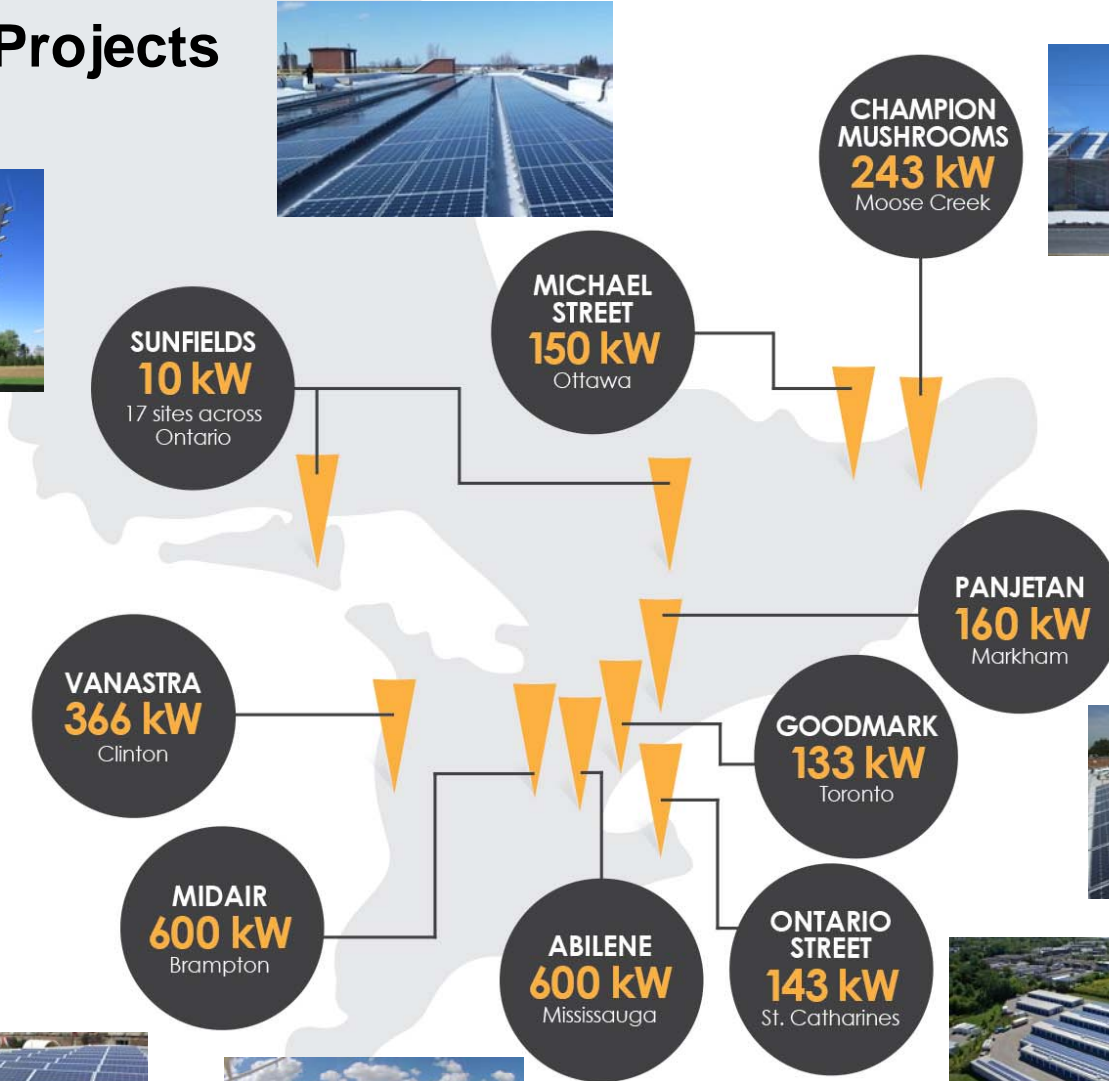


What We Do

- 20-Year Feed-in-Tariff Contracts with the Ontario Government
- Own and operate solar systems, with construction financed by Community Power Capital
- Refinance the systems by selling Solar Bonds to Ontarians
 - 5 Years, 5%, RRSP / TFSA eligible
 - 15 Years, 6%, Self-amortizing
- Engage our members and the public in renewable energy

The Investment

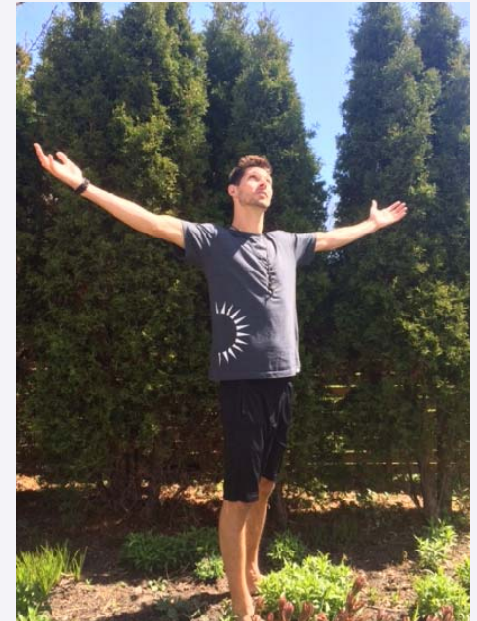
- 4-year bonds at 5% fixed interest, maturing April 2022; interest is simple and paid twice yearly in December & June. RRSP/TFSA eligible. Minimum investment is \$1000.
- 15-year bonds at 6% fixed interest maturing 2033; interest is self-amortizing and is paid twice yearly six months from after the date of purchase of the bonds. Minimum investment is \$10,000.



Our Members

- Nearly 1,400 members including individuals, small businesses, foundations, and unions
- 32% want to make an environmental impact
- 48% want a financial return & to make an environmental impact
- 19% seek impact investment opportunities
- 20% under the age of 40

80% of our members feel they have the power to make positive change in their community



Our Impact



Environmental

- 7 million kWh of clean electricity generated annually
- Powering over 1,600 homes by mid-2017
- Distributed energy improves grid efficiency and resilience
- Reduces greenhouse gases



Social

- Nearly 1,400 investors
- 50,000 people engaged annually at public events and online
- Improved support for renewable energy and project approval
- Democratic organization, one member, one vote



Economic

- Community power improves local economic impact by 50%
- For every dollar invested in FIT, two dollars returned to the community
- More than \$2.4 million in interest earned by members so far
