Street Improvements in the Maple Avenue Area

Project Update – February 2019

Maple Avenue Area 2019 construction will begin early-to-mid March with traffic control signage and the continuation of the watermain work on Maple Avenue.

The **tentative** construction timeline is from March 2019 until September 2019.

Maple Park Parking Lot	Full reconstruction	Spring 2019

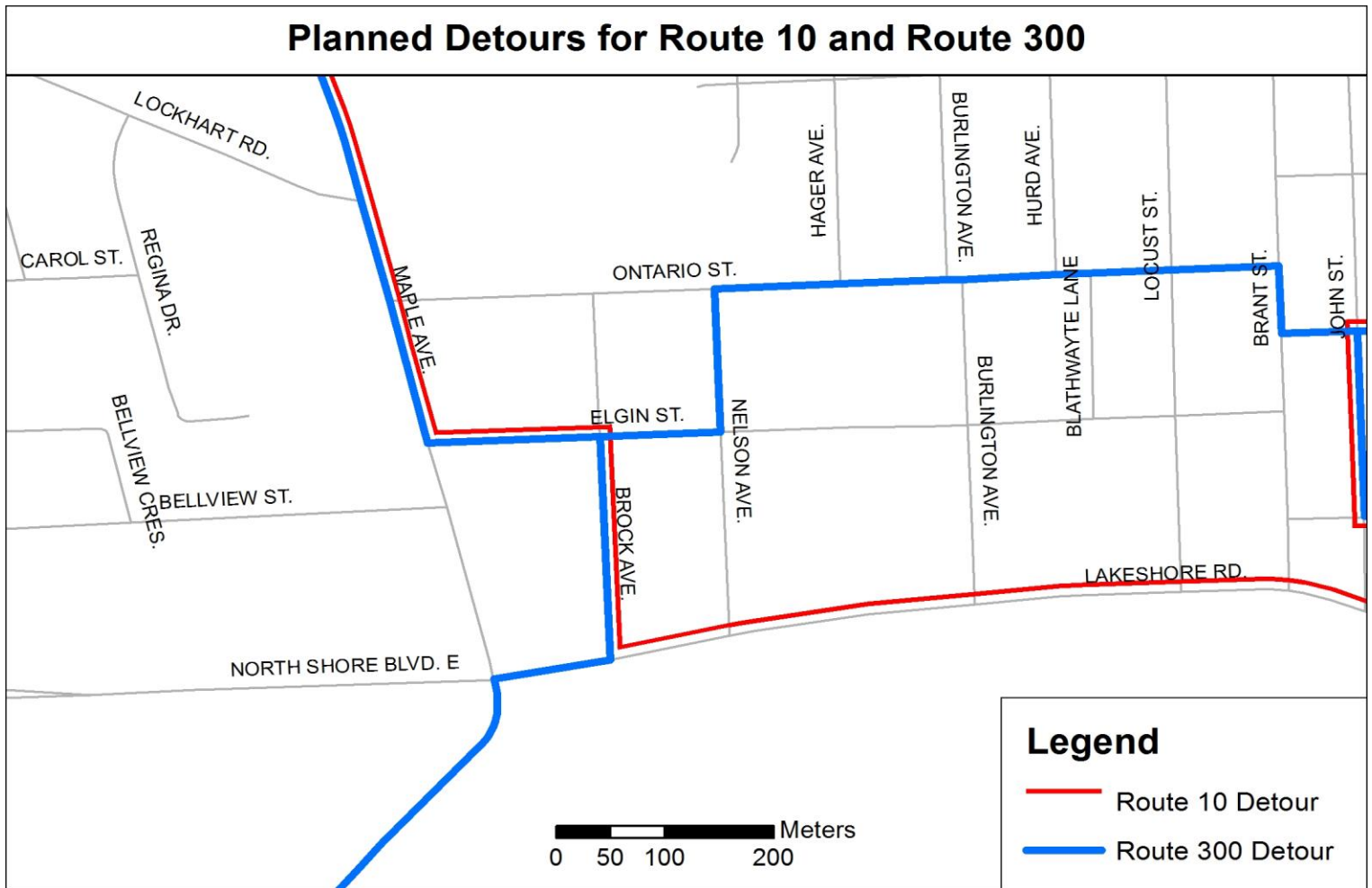

Burlington Transit Detour

To accommodate the construction of the watermain work on Maple Avenue and Ontario Street there will be Burlington Transit Detours.

Maple Avenue Transit detour - Spring 2019

Ontario Street Transit detour - February 4th, 2019 to June 2019



- Route 10 will detour via Brock Avenue and Elgin Street.
- Route 300 will detour via Nelson Avenue and Elgin Street.

Access to Your Property

During normal construction hours, Monday to Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., vehicle access to and from your property may be difficult. Driveways will be temporarily closed when work is being carried out in the immediate area. You will be notified in advance, by either the Inspector or the Contractor.

Parking

When you cannot access your driveway, please park on neighbouring streets where no construction is taking place and register your vehicle for the On-Street Parking Exemption Program at:

- www.burlington.ca/exemption

How does a parking exemption work?

- It allows a vehicle to park on the street beyond the 5-hour limit or overnight between 1 a.m. to 6 a.m., up to 15 days per calendar year, per license plate.
- The only two parking offences waived AFTER a vehicle is registered for a parking exemption are:
 1. park exceeding 5-hour limit
 2. park between 1 a.m. to 6 a.m.
- All other parking offences apply as they are not part of the parking exemption program.

During City construction projects

- The extra days will not be included in the 15-day per year limit when your driveway is not accessible.
- You must register your vehicle for this program so that you will not receive a parking ticket.

Watermain Construction

There may be some brief disruptions to water services at various times throughout the project. You will receive written notice of any scheduled shutdowns or disruptions a minimum of 48 hours before the water shut off.

- It may be necessary for our staff to enter your property to look at your existing water system. Your permission will be requested prior to entry. Please note, all Regional staff will carry photo identification.
- Night work may be required as part of this project. You will be notified in advance of any change in work hours.
- You may experience noise as a result of construction. Work will be scheduled in accordance with local noise by-laws.
- Emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times.

Your front lawn and driveway

As part of this project, some curb and sidewalk will be replaced. Some regrading of your boulevard lawn near the roadway will be required. All disturbances to your lawn, walkways and driveways will be restored.

Lawn Irrigation System

If you have a lawn irrigation system within the City's road allowance, please disconnect and remove any sprinkler heads within the City's road allowance. Please flag all other irrigation heads, so they are not damaged. The City or Region are not responsible for damaged heads within the road allowance.

Vibration

You may experience some minor vibration from construction equipment.

Garbage Pick up

Please continue to put your garbage and recycling out on the usual day. It is the contractor's responsibility to move your garbage to a location that can be accessed by the garbage truck and return your garbage containers. In order to help the Contractor, put your house number on your garbage cans and recycle bins.

Temporary Road Closures

There are no extended road closures scheduled on this project, although through traffic will be interrupted during the normal construction day.

- Maple Avenue will have ongoing lane closures.
- There will be times when Ontario Street will be temporarily closed when traffic cannot go past the construction equipment and trucks.

Mail Delivery

There is a chance mail delivery may be affected by the construction project.
