## Street Improvements in the Rexway Drive Area

### Project Update – May 2019

The City of Burlington and Halton Region have awarded this project to Coco Paving Inc.

Pre-condition surveys will begin the week of May 6, 2019 and will be carried out by dBA Services Inc. Signage and tree fencing work is scheduled to start the week of May 13, 2019. Construction is **tentatively** scheduled from the week of May 21, 2019 until September 2020.

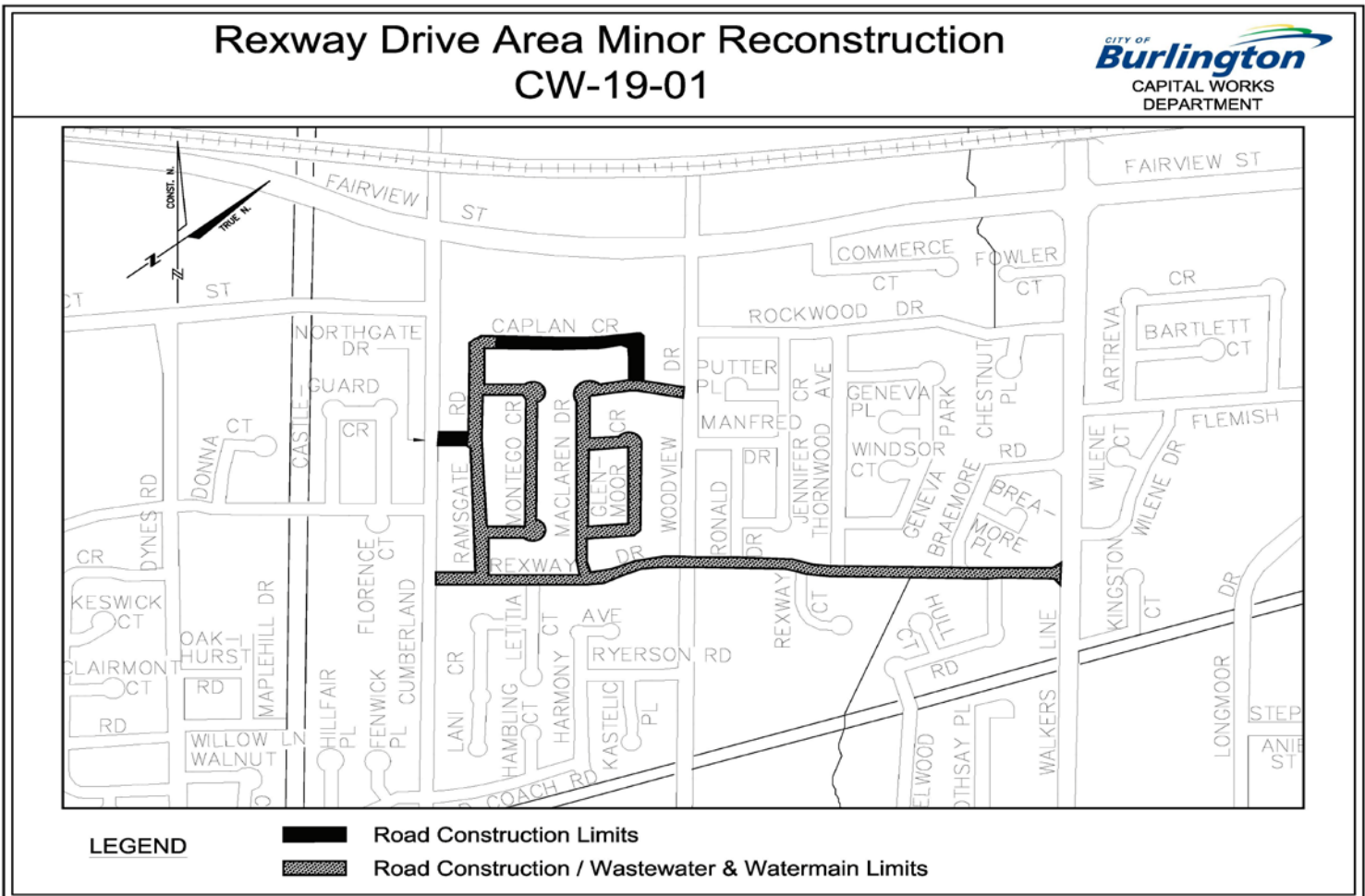

Ramsgate Road, Montego Crescent, Glen Moor Crescent, MacLaren Drive	Asphalt replacement, curb replacement, sidewalk repairs, storm sewer repairs, watermain/water service replacement.  Wastewater main and lateral replacement (MacLaren Drive only).	March to Fall 2020
Caplan Crescent, Northgate Drive	Asphalt replacement, curb replacement, sidewalk repairs, storm sewer repairs.  Full road base replacement. (Northgate Drive only)	March to Fall 2020

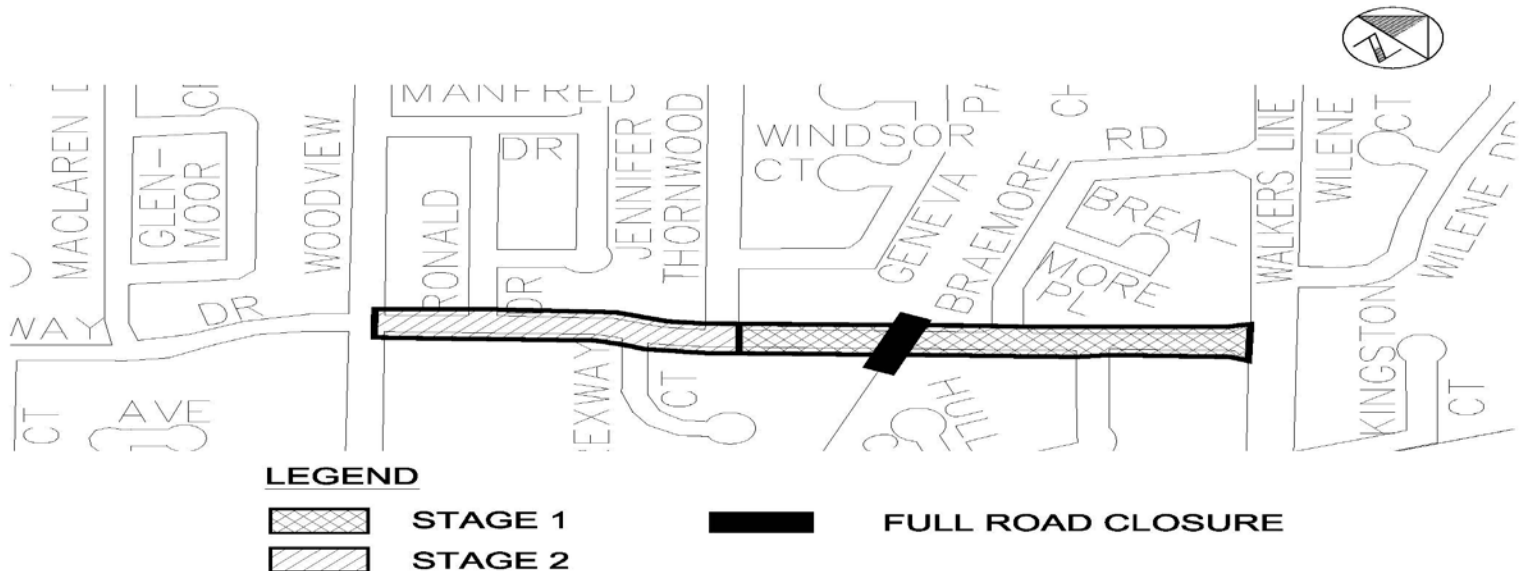




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## Road Closure/Staging

Sections of Rexway Drive will have scheduled road closures for watermain and servicing works.



Road Closure	Tentative Schedule
Stage 1: Walker's Line to Thornwood Avenue <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Local traffic only.</li> <li>Rexway Drive at Tuck Creek bridge will be <b>unpassable</b> in both directions.</li> <li>Elwood Road and Braemore Road closed at Rexway Drive, local access only.</li> </ul>	May 21, 2019 to Mid-June
Stage 2: Thornwood Avenue to Woodview Drive <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Local traffic only.</li> <li>Roland Drive closed at Rexway Drive, local access only.</li> </ul>	Early-June to Mid-July

All streets within the project limits will have temporary closures, as traffic will be unable to go past the construction equipment and trucks.

## Pre-condition Survey

dBA Services Inc. has been hired by Coco Paving Inc., under contract with City of Burlington to perform interior and exterior pre-condition photographic surveys of all buildings within the proposed project limits that may be affected by the construction activities. There is no cost to the resident/property owner to participate in this service. An additional notice and details about the pre-condition survey will follow from dBA.

## Access to Your Property

During normal construction hours, Monday to Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., vehicle access to and from your property may be difficult. Driveways will be temporarily closed when work is being carried out in the immediate area. You will be notified in advance, by either the Inspector or the Contractor.



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## **Parking**

When you cannot access your driveway, please park on neighbouring streets where no construction is taking place and register your vehicle for the On-Street Parking Exemption Program at:

## **How does a parking exemption work?**

- It allows a vehicle to park on the street beyond the 5-hour limit or overnight between 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., up to 15 days per calendar year, per license plate.
- The only two parking offences waived AFTER a vehicle is registered for a parking exemption are:
  1. park exceeding 5-hour limit
  2. park between 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.
- All other parking offences apply as they are not part of the parking exemption program.

## **During City construction projects**

- The extra days will not be included in the 15-day per year limit when your driveway is not accessible.
- You must register your vehicle for this program so that you will not receive a parking ticket.

## **Watermain Construction**

There may be some brief disruptions to water services at various times throughout the project. You will receive written notice of any scheduled shutdowns or disruptions a minimum of 48 hours before the water shut off.

- It may be necessary for our staff to enter your property to look at your existing water system. Your permission will be requested prior to entry. Please note, all Regional staff will carry photo identification.
- Night work may be required as part of this project. You will be notified in advance of any change in work hours.
- New fire hydrants will be installed within the road allowance as part of the watermain construction. A separate notice will be provided to those residents who will have a new fire hydrant installed in front of their property.
- There may be temporary periods of lower water pressure during the installation of the new watermain. Regular pressure will be restored once the new watermain is installed.
- You may experience noise as a result of construction. Work will be scheduled in accordance with local noise by-laws.
- Emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times.

## **Wastewater Services**



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The Contractor may ask you to restrict your water usage at specific times during the course of construction. This should only last for a limited amount of time while they rehabilitate and/or replace your service.

## **Your Front Lawn and Driveway**

As part of this project, some curb and sidewalk will be replaced. Some re-grading of your boulevard lawn near the roadway will be required. All disturbances to your lawn, walkways and driveways will be restored.

## **Lawn Irrigation System**

If you have a lawn irrigation system within the City's road allowance, please disconnect and remove any sprinkler heads within the City's road allowance. Please flag all other irrigation heads, so they are not damaged. The City or Region are not responsible for damaged heads within the road allowance.

## **Tree Removals**

To accommodate this project, tree removals may be required. Some pruning of hazardous trees and limbs may also be required.

## **Vibration**

You may experience some minor vibration from construction equipment. As a precaution, we recommend that you remove or secure objects on shelves and walls.

## **Dust and Mud**

There will be increased levels of dust and mud near the work site. The contractor is required to manage these impacts.

## **Garbage Pick up**

Please continue to put your garbage and recycling out on the usual day. It is the contractor's responsibility to move your garbage to a location that can be accessed by the garbage truck and return your garbage containers. In order to help the contractor, please put your house number on your garbage cans and recycle bins.

## **Mail Delivery**

There is a chance mail delivery may be affected by the construction project.
