Road Closure/Staging

Sections of Rexway Drive will have scheduled road closures for watermain and servicing works.

Road Closure	Tentative Schedule (2019)
Rexway Drive – Cumberland Avenue to Maclaren Drive <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Local traffic only. • Rexway Drive will be unpassable at times during the regular construction day for the replacement of wastewater laterals. 	Mid-October to end of October
Rexway Drive - Woodview Drive to Maclaren Drive <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A rolling road closure will be in effect for the installation of watermain and services. • Watermain work will begin at Woodview and work west to Maclaren Dr. and may be unpassable during the regular construction day. 	Mid-October to mid-November
Rexway Drive – Maclaren Drive to Cumberland Avenue <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A rolling road closure will be in effect for the installation of watermain and services. 	Early November to the end of November

*Please note the schedule is subject to weather. All streets within the project limits will have temporary closures. Traffic will be unable to go past the construction equipment and trucks.

Access to Your Property

During normal construction hours, Monday to Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., vehicle access to and from your property may be difficult. Driveways will be temporarily closed when work is being carried out in the immediate area. You will be notified in advance, by either the Inspector or the Contractor.

Watermain Construction

There may be some brief disruptions to water services at various times throughout the project. You will receive written notice of any scheduled shutdowns or disruptions a minimum of 48 hours before the water shut off.

- It may be necessary for our staff to enter your property to look at your existing water system. Your permission will be requested prior to entry. Please note, all Regional staff will carry photo identification.
- Night work may be required as part of this project. You will be notified in advance of any change in work hours.
- New fire hydrants will be installed within the road allowance as part of the watermain construction. A separate notice will be provided to those residents who will have a new fire hydrant installed in front of their property.
- There may be temporary periods of lower water pressure during the installation of the new watermain. Regular pressure will be restored once the new watermain is installed.
- You may experience noise as a result of construction. Work will be scheduled in accordance with local noise by-laws.

- Emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times.

Wastewater Services

The Contractor may ask you to restrict your water usage at specific times during the course of construction. This should only last for a limited amount of time while they rehabilitate and/or replace your service.

Your Front Lawn and Driveway

As part of this project, some curb and sidewalk will be replaced. Some re-grading of your boulevard lawn near the roadway will be required. All disturbances to your lawn, walkways and driveways will be restored. The sod from Cumberland Drive to Woodview Road may not be placed in 2019.

Lawn Irrigation System

If you have a lawn irrigation system within the City's road allowance, please disconnect and remove any sprinkler heads within the City's road allowance. Please flag all other irrigation heads, so they are not damaged. The City or Region are not responsible for damaged heads within the road allowance.

Tree Removals

To accommodate this project, tree removals may be required. Some pruning of hazardous trees and limbs may also be required.

Vibration

You may experience some minor vibration from construction equipment. As a precaution, we recommend that you remove or secure objects on shelves and walls.

Garbage Pick up

Please continue to put your garbage and recycling out on the usual day. It is the contractor's responsibility to move your garbage to a location that can be accessed by the garbage truck and return your garbage containers. In order to help the contractor, please put your house number on your garbage cans and recycle bins.

Mail Delivery

There is a chance mail delivery may be affected by the construction project.
