Project Schedule

Rexway Drive Area 2020 construction will begin late February, early March, with traffic control signage and storm sewer works on various streets north of Rexway Drive.

The **tentative** construction timeline is from March 2020 until September 2020.

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Snow Removal and Maintenance

Once operations resume the Contractor will be responsible for snow removal in the area of active construction for the remainder of the winter season.

Driveway Restoration

Driveways affected during the 2019 construction on Rexway Dr., from Cumberland Ave. to Woodview Dr., that were restored temporarily, will be restored permanently in 2020. This will include the restoration of driveway pavers, curbing, interlocking brick, and any outstanding driveways between Woodview Dr. and Walkers Ln.

Sod Restoration

All disturbed grassed areas will be fully restored with topsoil and sod in late Spring 2020, weather dependant.

Parking

When you cannot access your driveway, please park on neighbouring streets where no construction is taking place and register your vehicle for the On-Street Parking Exemption Program at:

How does a parking exemption work?

- It allows a vehicle to park on the street beyond the 5-hour limit or overnight between 1 a.m. to 6 a.m., up to 15 days per calendar year, per license plate.
- The only two parking offences waived AFTER a vehicle is registered for a parking exemption are:
 1. park exceeding 5-hour limit
 2. park between 1 a.m. to 6 a.m.
- All other parking offences apply as they are not part of the parking exemption program.

During City construction projects

- The extra days will not be included in the 15-day per year limit when your driveway is not accessible.
- You must register your vehicle for this program so that you will not receive a parking ticket.

Watermain Construction

There may be some brief disruptions to water services at various times throughout the project. You will receive written notice of any scheduled shutdowns or disruptions a minimum of 48 hours before the water shut off.

- It may be necessary for our staff to enter your property to look at your existing water system. Your permission will be requested prior to entry. Please note, all Regional staff will carry photo identification.
- This project may require night work. You will be notified in advance of any change in work hours.
- You may experience noise as a result of construction. Work will be scheduled in accordance with local noise by-laws.
- Emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times.



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Your front lawn and driveway

As part of this project, some curb and sidewalk will be replaced. Some regrading of your boulevard/lawn near the roadway will be required. All disturbances to your lawn, walkways, and driveways will be restored.

Lawn Irrigation System

If you have a lawn irrigation system within the City's road allowance, please disconnect and remove any sprinkler heads within the City's road allowance. Please flag all other irrigation heads, so they are not damaged. The City or Region are not responsible for damaged heads within the road allowance.

Vibration

You may experience some minor vibration from construction equipment.

Garbage Pick up

Please continue to put your garbage and recycling out on the usual day. It is the Contractor's responsibility to move your garbage to a location that can be accessed by the garbage truck and return your garbage containers. In order to help the Contractor, put your house number on your garbage cans and recycle bins.

Temporary Road Closures and Property Access

There are no extended road closures scheduled on this project, although through traffic will be interrupted during the normal construction day. During normal construction hours, Monday to Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., vehicle access to and from your property may be difficult. Driveways will be temporarily closed when work is being carried out in the immediate area. You will be notified in advance, by either the Inspector or the Contractor.
