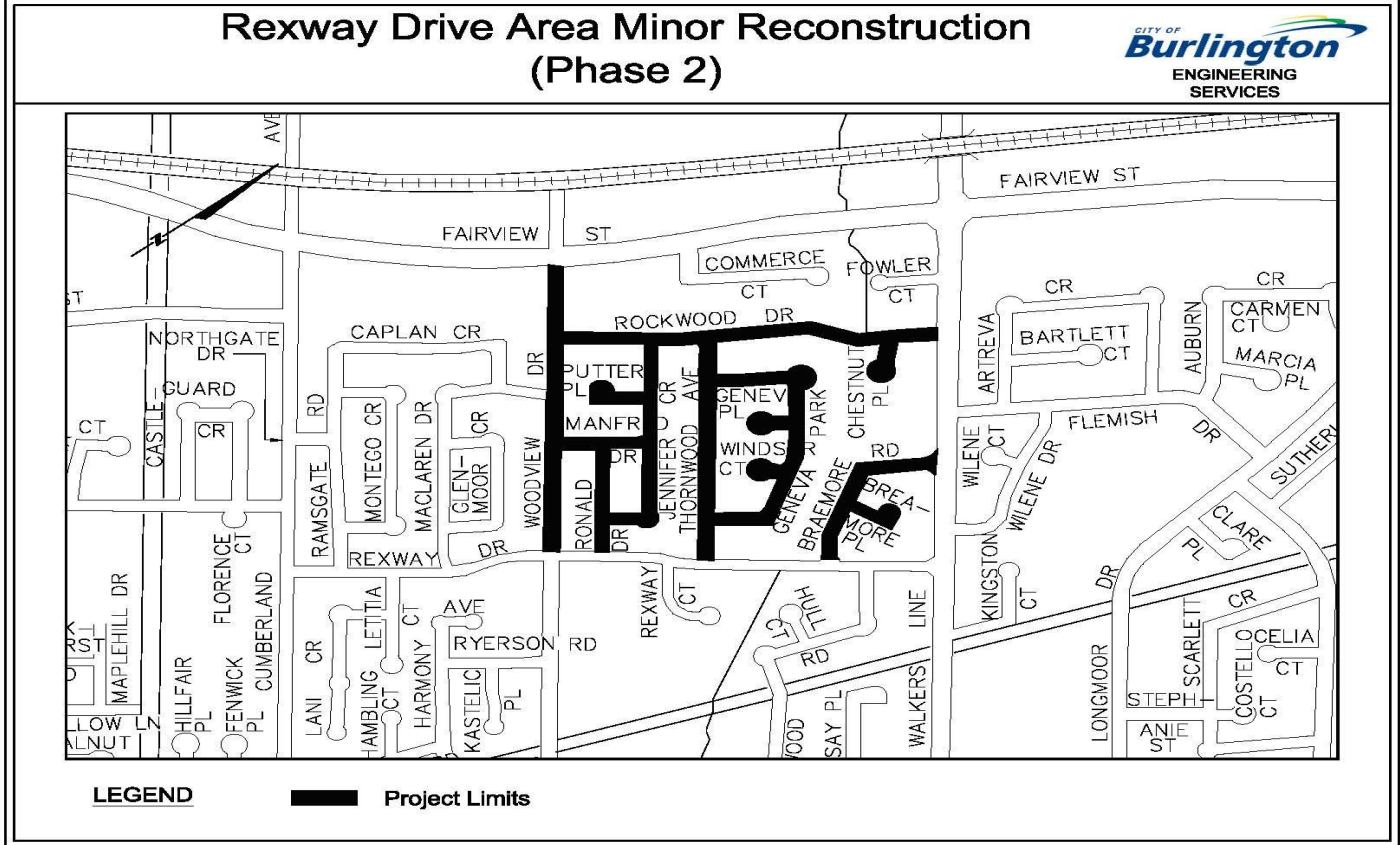
### COVID-19 Information

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## **Utility**

Disruption to your home internet or telephone service may occur. This is a concern for those working and schooling from home, the City has flagged this concern with utility companies. Our goal is to have internet disconnections repaired by the provider within 24 hours. The Contractor will typically contact the utility company, however, if you lose service, please inform your utility provider and the City of the interruption.

## **Accessing your Property**

During normal construction hours, Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., vehicle access to and from your property may be difficult. Driveways will be temporarily closed when work is being carried out in the immediate area. You will be notified in advance, by either the City Inspector or the Contractor.

## **Parking**

When you cannot access your driveway, please park on neighbouring streets where no construction is taking place. If you are asked to leave your vehicle on road overnight, register your vehicle for the On-Street Parking Exemption Program at: [Burlington.ca/Exemption](http://Burlington.ca/Exemption)

## **Your front lawn and driveway**

As part of this project, the curb and some area of sidewalk will be replaced. Some re-grading of your boulevard lawn near the road will be needed. Any damage to your lawn, walkways and driveways will be restored.

For information regarding driveway credits, please visit the project website.

## **Lawn Irrigation System**

If you have a lawn irrigation system within the City's road allowance, please disconnect and remove these sprinkler heads. Please flag all other irrigation heads so they are not damaged. The City is not responsible for damaged heads within the road allowance.

## **Tree Removals**

Tree protection barriers will be erected around all trees within the right-of-way. Some trees will require removal or pruning.

## **Vibration**

You may experience some minor vibration from construction equipment. As a precaution, we recommend that you remove or secure objects on shelves and walls.

## **Dust and Mud**

During construction, there will be increased levels of dust and mud throughout the project limits. The contractor is required to manage these impacts.



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## **Waste Pick up**

Please continue to put your waste and recycling out on your usual day. The Contractor will move your garbage to a location that can be accessed by the garbage truck and return your containers. To help the Contractor, please put your house number on your garbage cans and recycle bins.

## **Traffic Impacts**

There will be regular temporary lane restrictions during construction.

## **Mail Delivery**

Canada Post will provide mail delivery to a single-point pick-up. More information will be provided by Canada Post.

## **Watermain Works**

There will be interruptions to your water service during construction while completing watermain tie-ins and when transferring the houses to the new watermain. Halton Region will provide 48 hours advanced notice of all scheduled service interruptions.

Some watermain installation and tie-in work may be required to take place at night.
