Rexway Drive Reconstruction

City of Burlington Contract CW 19-01

Re: Sanitary sewer lateral service rehabilitation

As you are aware, Coco Paving is completing the road reconstruction, watermain and Sanitary sewer works on Rexway Drive between Walkers Line and Cumberland Avenue for the City of Burlington and the Region of Halton.

As part of this project, the Region of Halton is undertaking the rehabilitation of the sanitary sewer lateral pipes within the right-of-way fronting on your property by means of relining or Cured-in-Place-Pipe (CIPP). A sanitary sewer lateral is the pipe that connects your house to the mainline sewers on the street in order to collect sanitary waste. Your house has been identified as suitable for lateral replacement via CIPP and not via open cut excavation as the rest of the houses on the street due to the presence of underground utility cables and/or presence of tree in the vicinity of the existing lateral. (CIPP being a much less intrusive method).

In order to perform this work by CIPP method, Coco Paving has entered into a contract with **Hamilton Sewer and Water Services (HSWS)** of Hamilton, Ontario who specializes in this particular area of work.

As a means to help in the construction, **HSWS** would like access to the sewer pipes in the basement. The crews will perform a video survey of the sewer lateral pipe from your house to the mainline sewer in order for them to gain an understanding of the existing lateral (initial appointment is typically 10-15 minutes). If the CIPP possibility exists, we would like to install the liner using the access location in your basement. We will be cleaning the pipe in preparation for lining from your basement to the sewer under the street at no cost to the property owner (provided that access to your property is acceptable).

In order to schedule this work to be completed, it is asked that you please contact **Tom Tuite** of **HSWS** at **1-905-741-8991** at your earliest opportunity. Your prompt response in this matter would be appreciated. Tom will review the potential access from your basement to complete the proposed lining of the sanitary service. We offer an opportunity to not only video the entire sanitary lateral including the portion from the house to the property line but we can also clean out any potential roots or calcification that might be evident in the line.



We realize construction is disruptive and we have appreciated your patience through the process already.
