TUCK CREEK FLOOD MITIGATION, PHASE 1 Regal Road Bridge Upgrade and Channel Works

The City of Burlington completed the Tuck Creek Flood Assessment and Crossing Upgrades Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study, between New Street and Spruce Avenue, in June 2016. The study was done because of the extreme rain the city had on Aug. 4, 2014 during which the creek overtopped by flood waters. To reduce flooding risk, the study recommended stormwater infrastructure upgrades in the study area. The recommended works will be constructed in three phases:

Phase 1

Phase 1 will include an upgrade to the Regal Road Bridge and channel works from New Street to Spruce Avenue. The detailed design is now complete and currently going through permitting process. Construction is anticipated to begin this fall.

You are invited to the Public Information Centre (PIC) where you can discuss the project and get more information on the construction, including design, site access, tree preservation and plantings.
