

Moon in June Road Race

Road / Lane Closures and Traffic Restrictions

Saturday, June 2, 2018

The 27th annual Moon in June Road Race has a one km kids' race at 6:30 p.m. and 5k and 10k races beginning at 8 p.m. on Saturday, June 2. These races require road and lane closures in Burlington. Streets will reopen as soon as possible following the end of the race. Vehicles parked illegally in the area will be tagged or towed to allow emergency access.



Road Closures

- James Street between John Street and Brant Street will be closed to traffic between 4:30 and 11:30 p.m.
- Brant Street between Ontario Street and Elgin Street will be closed to traffic between 5 and 11 p.m.
- Brant Street between Caroline Street and Lakeshore Road will be closed to traffic between 6 and 11 p.m.

Traffic Lane Closures

- Lakeshore Road, John Street to Brant Street and John Street to Pine Street, between 6:30 and 7:30 p.m.
- Southbound Brant Street between Baldwin and Caroline Street.
- All other streets on the race route will have one lane open for local access.

Resident Access

- Emergency Services access will be maintained at all times along the event route.

Supervision

- Route management: Police will direct traffic at major intersections and event marshals will help runners and motorists at multi-residential driveways and on side streets.
- Race notices were delivered to all residences, religious centres and businesses affected by the races.

Parking Restrictions Posted

- Please remember to obey all parking bylaws.
- See parking rules at each pay machine.
- Do not park in restricted areas.
