

Blanket Raffle Requirements

In order for an organization to conduct lottery schemes in the City of Burlington, all organizations must first apply for eligibility through the municipality. If the organization is approved to conduct lottery events, the organization can then apply.

A Blanket Raffle allows for more than one type of lottery scheme to be conducted under a single lottery licence. A blanket raffle can be issued for a fixed time period (maximum of 6 months), and has a maximum total prize value of \$5000.00. Blanket raffles can include stub raffles, elimination raffles, 50/50 raffles, meat spins/turkey rolls and “name the raffle” raffles.

The review of a raffle application can take up to 15 business days. Incomplete applications may result in a delay in processing.

The following information must be completed and submitted with each raffle application:

- The number of tickets to be printed for each individual raffle event

- The scheduled dates for each individual raffle event (see reverse for sample schedule)

- A detailed explanation of the rules for each type of raffle event (please attach a separate page for each event)

- Sample ticket – must include the following information:

- Lottery licence number
- Licensee’s name
- Location of draw, dates and times of draws
- Total number of tickets printed
- Descriptions of prizes including retail value (supporting receipts if value is over \$500)
- Price of ticket
- Ticket number

If tickets and/or advertisements are in any language other than English – full translation of the information must be presented and a sample of the text to be used on the ticket must be shown.

- Licence fee: 3% of the total prize value (Total prize value must be at least 20% of the projected total value of all tickets printed)
