The City of Burlington awarded this project to Rankin Construction Inc.

Construction activity is scheduled to commence the week of May 27th with signage and tree protection being installed, weather permitting. The tentative construction timelines are presented below.

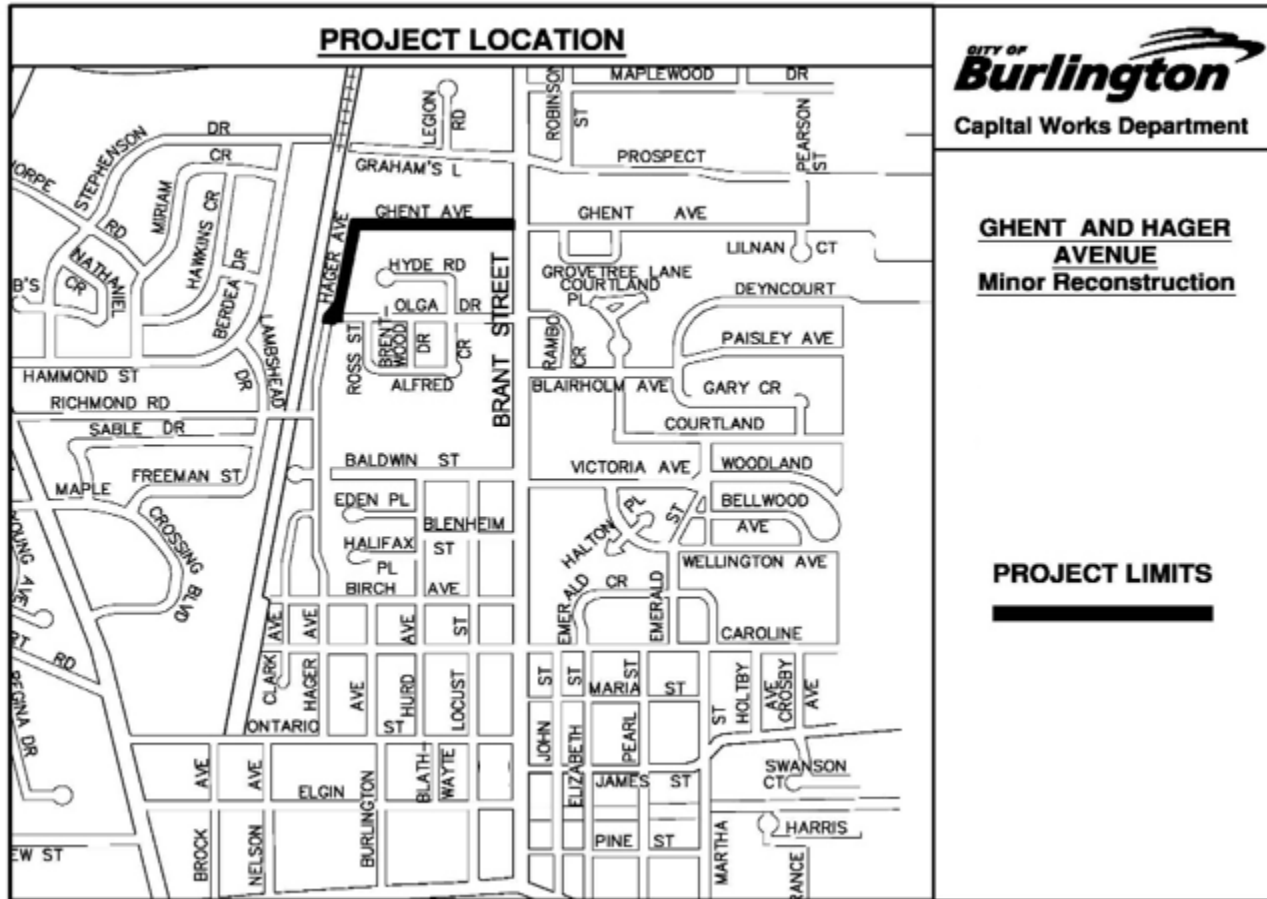

Access to Your Property

During normal construction hours, Monday to Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., vehicle access to and from your property may be difficult. Driveways will be temporarily closed when work is being carried out in the immediate area. You will be notified in advance, by either the City Inspector or the Contractor.

Access to multi-residential properties with a single driveway will be maintained throughout the project by staging the curb and sidewalk replacement work. A minimum of one driveway will remain open for multi-residential properties with more than one driveway access point.

Parking

When you cannot access your driveway, please park on neighbouring streets where no construction is taking place and register your vehicle for the On-Street Parking Exemption Program at:

- www.burlington.ca/exemption
- 24-hour mailbox: 905-335-7844

How does a parking exemption work?

- It allows a vehicle to park on the street beyond the 5-hour limit or overnight between 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., up to 15 days per calendar year, per license plate.
- The only two parking offences waived AFTER a vehicle is registered for a parking exemption are:
 1. park exceeding 5-hour limit
 2. park between 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.
- All other parking offences apply as they are not part of the parking exemption program.

During City construction projects

- The extra days will not be included in the 15-day per year limit when your driveway is not accessible.
- You must register your vehicle for this program so that you will not receive a parking ticket.

Your Front Lawn and Driveway

As part of this project, some curb and sidewalk will be replaced. Some re-grading of your boulevard lawn near the roadway will be required. All disturbances to your lawn, walkways and driveways will be restored.

Lawn Irrigation System

If you have a lawn irrigation system within the City's road allowance, please disconnect and remove any sprinkler heads within the City's road allowance. Please flag all other irrigation heads, so they are not damaged. The City is not responsible for damaged heads within the road allowance.

Tree Impacts

To accommodate this project, some pruning of hazardous trees and limbs may also be required. There are no trees identified to be removed as part of this project.

Vibration

You may experience some minor vibration from construction equipment. As a precaution, we recommend that you remove or secure objects on shelves and walls.

Dust and Mud

There will be increased levels of dust and mud near the work site. The contractor is required to manage these impacts.

Garbage Pick up

Please continue to put your garbage and recycling out on the usual day. It is the contractor's responsibility to move your garbage to a location that can be accessed by the garbage truck and return your garbage containers. In order to help the contractor, please put your house number on your garbage cans and recycle bins.

Temporary Road Closures

All streets will have temporary lane restrictions.

Mail Delivery

There is a chance mail delivery may be affected by the construction project. Canada Post has been notified of this project.
