Dear Resident/Business Owner/Tenant:

**Re: Waterdown Road North Rehabilitation and Capacity Improvements – Craven Ave. to Mountain Brow Road**

The City of Burlington, City of Hamilton and Halton Region will be holding a joint Public Information Centre to present the 90% Design of Waterdown Road.

The proposed construction will consist of the following works:

- Road widening to accommodate an ultimate 4 lane cross section. The road will be striped as a 3 lane cross section until traffic volumes increase.
- Installation of curb and gutter and a multi-use pathway on the west side
- Storm Sewer Installation
- New Traffic Signal at Waterdown Road and Mountain Brow Road
- New Street Lighting
- Watermain Replacement (Includes watermain replacement on Flatt Road and Ireson Road)
- Utility Relocations and Landscaping

Residents and property owners will have an opportunity to review and comment on the project drawings, review property and driveway implications, and discuss any potential disruptions that may be caused from the construction of the proposed works. Comments and information regarding the project will be collected to assist the project team during the finalization of the Detailed Design process. This material will be maintained on file for use during the project.

Representatives from Halton Region, the City of Hamilton and the City of Burlington will be in attendance to answer any questions. The meeting will be held on:
