Burlington's New Official Plan Project

Community Consultation on the Draft New Official Plan

May 1, 2017

The draft new Official Plan has been released for community consultation.

The draft new Official Plan articulates Burlington's vision to 2031 and beyond, and has been developed in recognition of the opportunities and challenges ahead as the City continues to evolve. The draft new Official Plan fuses local community interests with regional and provincial plans, regulations and legislation, in alignment with the [City's Strategic Plan](#).

Feedback will be collected on the draft new Official Plan until **June 30th**. Comments submitted before the June 30th deadline will be considered in the development of the proposed Official Plan for adoption by City Council by the end of 2017.
