TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Burlington passed By-Law No. 24-2018 on the 26th day of April, 2018, under sections 17 and 26 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O 1990, c.P.13, as amended, for the purposes of adopting a new Official Plan for the City of Burlington.

Purpose and Effect

The purpose and effect of By-law 24-2018 is to adopt *Grow Bold: Burlington Official Plan* (April 2018) as the new Official Plan for the City of Burlington. The new Official Plan fuses local community interests with regional and provincial policy direction, in alignment with the City's Strategic Plan, articulating Burlington's vision to 2031 and beyond, towards a mature state. The Official Plan establishes a set of principles to guide land use decision making to achieve sustainable development and a complete community in accordance with

The adopted new Official Plan for the City of Burlington will be submitted to the Region of Halton for approval. As the approval authority for the new Official Plan, the Region may approve, modify and approve, or refuse to approve the new Official Plan.
