Parking Lot 7 – 500 Locust St.

- Replace pavement.
- 66 new parking spots and 3 new accessible parking spots.
- Additional lighting.
- Replace sidewalk along Caroline Street.

Parking Lot Closures

Parking Lot 7 – May 2019

Parking Lot 7 will be fully closed for up to one week for paving, line painting and fence/tree installation.

Parking Lot 3 – April 15 to May 2019

The west side of Parking Lot 3 will be closed create more parking spaces.

The parking lots will have a gravel surface during construction. The contractor will suppress any dust and/or nuisance with a dust-controlling agent.

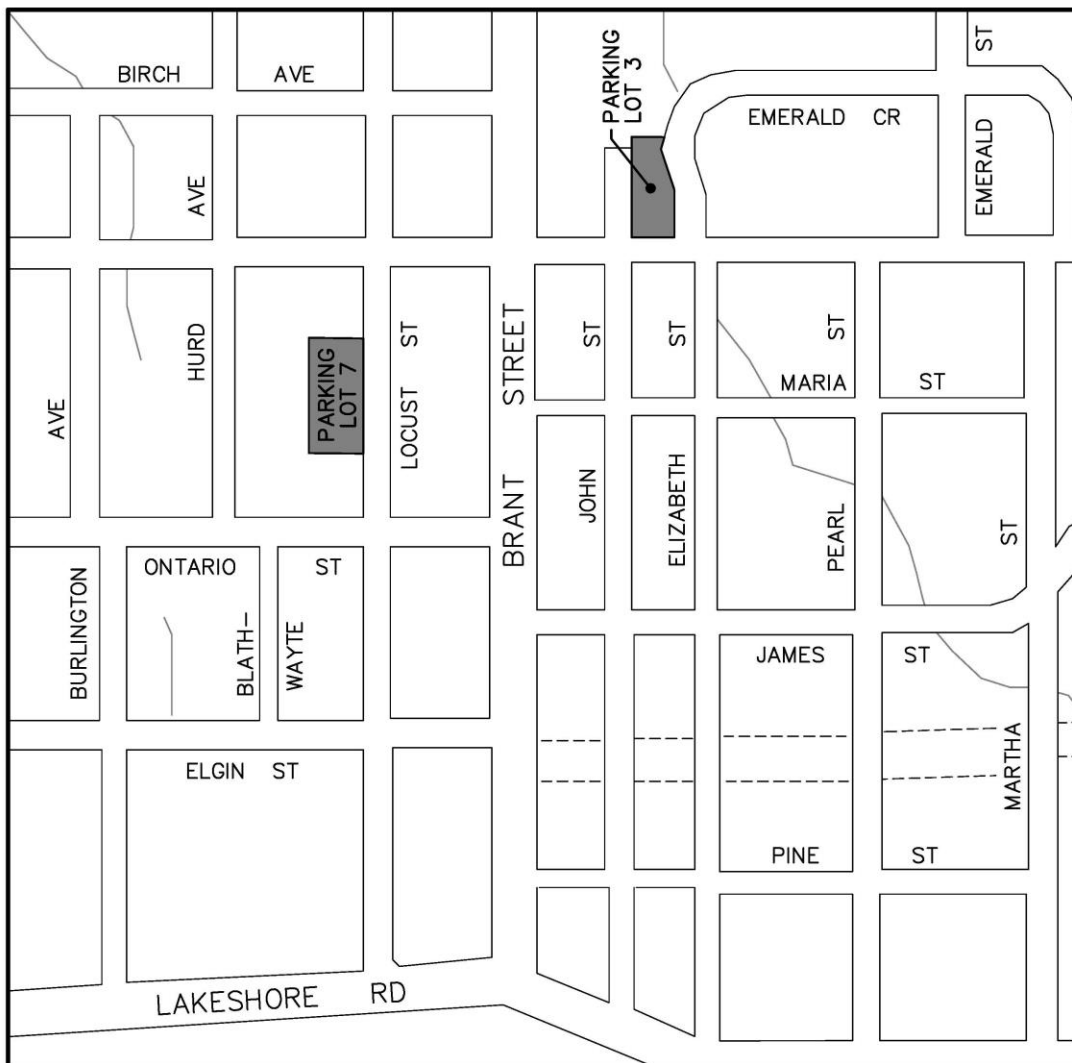
Vibration

PARKING LOT 7 RECONSTRUCTION AND PARKING LOT 3 EXTENSION



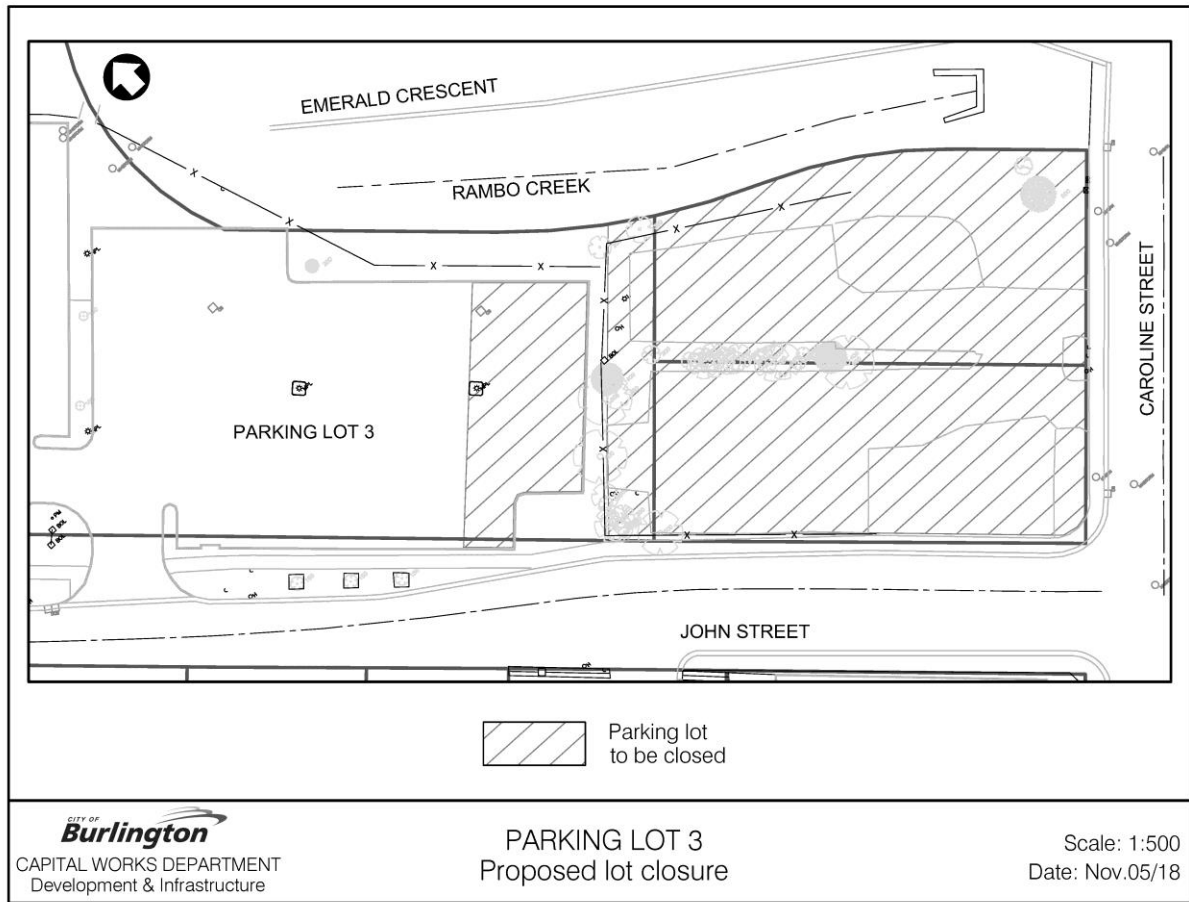
