DECKS AND ROOFED OVER PATIOS (RESIDENTIAL)

City of Burlington Zoning By-law 2020

Definitions

Deck: A platform or series of platform, accessory to a dwelling unit, exceeding a height of 60 cm measured from the lowest point of grade at platform perimeter to the floor of the platform. Decks may be free-standing or attached to a dwelling and are intended for use as an outdoor living area. Decks may be roofed over, screened-in and enclosed by a hand rail not exceeding a height of 122 cm above the platform floor, otherwise a deck shall not be enclosed.

Patio: A platform or series of platforms, accessory to a dwelling unit, having a height of up to 60 cm measured from the lowest point of grade at the platform perimeter to the floor of the platform. Patios may be free-standing or attached to a dwelling and are intended for use as an outdoor living area. Patios may be roofed over, screened in, and enclosed by a hand rail not exceeding a height of 122 cm above the platform floor, otherwise a patio shall be enclosed.

Question #1: Is your deck 0.6m - 1.2m high?




