

ADDITION: HEIGHT (PEAKED ROOF) REGULATIONS

City of Burlington Zoning By-law 2020

Peaked roof: A roof having a slope equal to or greater than 1:10

Additions and enlargements to existing dwellings are permitted to a maximum height of two storeys measured from ceiling of the existing dwelling. A maximum of 6m to the peak of the roof for a two storey or 4.5m maximum to the peak of the roof for one or one and a half story.
