BY-LAW NUMBER 111-1988

A By-law to authorize the use of Composite Ballots at Municipal Elections.

WHEREAS pursuant to the Municipal Elections Act, Chapter 308, Section 45(1) and (2), R.S.O. 1980 as amended, the Council of a municipality may pass a by-law prior to the first day of October in an election year to authorize the use of composite ballots at a Municipal Election;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to use a composite ballot at municipal elections;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BURLINGTON HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

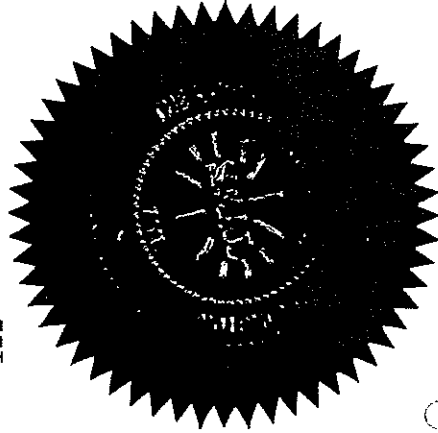
1. THAT the use of the composite ballot for Municipal Elections is hereby authorized in a form as shown as Schedules "A", "B" and "C" attached hereto.
2. A composite ballot may contain the names of candidates for the offices of the Municipal and Regional Councils, the Halton Board of Education, the Halton Roman Catholic Separate School Board (English and French Language), the Hydro-Electric Commission, as well as any question or by-law on which a vote is to be taken.
3. THAT the ballot form shall be amended as required for any election so as to provide the date of the election, the required number of spaces for all the candidates seeking office at that particular election, and also to provide for any number of questions on which a vote has to be taken.
4. THAT By-law 124-1980 is hereby repealed.
