City of Burlington By-law 57-2016

A bylaw to authorize the use of internet voting as an alternative method for advance voting for the 2014 Municipal Election and repeal By-law 89-2013  
File: 165-01 (CL-2016)

Whereas Section 42 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996, SO 1996, c32* provides that the Council may, by by-law, authorize the use of an alternate voting method that does not require electors to attend at a voting place in order to vote; and

Whereas Section 42 (5) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996, SO 1996, c32* provides when a by-law authorizing the use of an alternative voting method is in effect, sections 43 apply only if the by-law so specifies; and

Whereas Section 42 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996, SO 1996, c 32* provides that the Council of a Municipality may, by by-law, authorize the use of optical scanning vote tabulators for the purpose of counting votes at Municipal Elections.

Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Burlington enacts as follows:

- 1) The use of optical scanning vote tabulators for the purpose of counting votes in municipal election hereby be authorized; and
- 2) The use of internet voting as an alternative voting method for voting is hereby authorized as per Section 43 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996, SO 1996, c32*.
- 3) That By-law 89-2013 be hereby repealed.
